IT'S A GREAT DAY TO LEARN ABOUT JESUS

Outside of Sunday, Tuesday is arguably the most exciting day of the week at FBC Tifton. Most of you know about the Red Door College Ministry and how God is revolutionizing the lives of college students across our congregation. But just a few hours before Red Door, across the street in the Red Door Building, our preteens gather for Fuse Preteen Ministry, and God is doing something miraculous in the lives of our 4th- and 5th-grade students.

Seven years ago, the Lord began to cultivate a deep burden in my heart. There was a distinct attendance drop-off among our 4th- and 5th-graders in Sunday morning and Wednesday night ministries. I began to realize that our preteens felt "too cool" for Kids Ministry but not yet ready for Student Ministry. If I wanted to get serious about loving and leading that age demographic, I had to create an actual, visible, and consistent place where they knew they belonged. Fuse Preteen Ministry was born from this burden.

Fuse began in the Fall of 2018 in the FLC Craft Room with three students and me. We had snacks, played a board game, and opened our Bible to read and learn straight from scripture. It was small but impactful. Soon, we grew to fifteen, and I realized that every preteen needs peer relationships and a consistent adult who knows their name and what is happening in their life.

In the Summer of 2019, we converted the old children's library into a dedicated space for the Fuse Ministry. From Fall 2019 to Spring 2023, we grew from fifteen to 30. In the fall of 2023, we moved across the street into the Red Door Building. Over the course of our two years over there, we have grown from 30 to an average of 43, with our highest Tuesday being 52 preteens. Numbers matter because every number represents a child who is hearing God's Word. The Kids Team, led by Carter Brooks's vision, renovated the Red Door Building this summer, and it has truly become a space where preteens know they belong.

Fuse has had a ripple effect throughout the Kids Ministry. Our Sunday and Wednesday attendance for 4th- and 5th-graders is consistently higher than ever. Families whose first interaction with FBC was through their preteen coming to Fuse with a friend are now engaged as church members. Most importantly, God has used the teaching time during Fuse to reveal Himself to save preteens. Since our inception, we have seen 18 preteens walk from death to life through the course of their time in Fuse.

Fuse meets from 3:00 to 5:00pm at the Red Door Building. Drop off can occur anytime between 3:00 and 4:00pm. I recognize that peer relationships are significant to preteens' social development. Therefore, we start with an hour of free fellowship. This fellowship is a time when students choose their activity, and I focus on small, impactful conversations with each child. Since it is immediately after school, I offer snacks and drinks. From 4:00 to 4:30 pm, we engage in intentional Bible time. Typically, I take a book of the Bible and go verse by verse through it. This process is methodical, teaching kids how to read scripture and apply it to their lives. I always tell them, "There are two types of people in this room. One who doesn't know Jesus and is still building the foundation for the Gospel to take root, and one who does know Jesus and can learn from scripture how to live like Jesus." I craft my lesson so that each preteen can glean something from it. We finish up with parent pick up from 4:30 to 5:00pm. The timeframe is perfect because it fills the time immediately after school and before any sports or dance activities.

I often get asked by other Kids Ministry leaders, "What is the secret to the growth of your Preteen Ministry?" I tell them the growth of our Fuse Ministry is not driven by gimmicks or giveaways. It is driven by preteens who absolutely love "Tuesday Fuse-day." They go to school, tell their friends how awesome Fuse is, and, in turn, their friends check it out, love it, and invite their friends. It is truly spectacular to see how preteen word of mouth has grown this ministry. In fact, it has challenged me. How often am I willing to tell my neighbor about the amazing things God is doing in my life and at FBC?

Fuse Preteen Ministry is just another testimony to the miraculous power of God working in our midst. It is truly incredible to see nearly 50 preteens flood the Red Door playing basketball, football, 4-square, wiffle ball, PS5, Uno, eating snacks, and simply passing the time talking, all while waiting to hear from God's Word. If you know a 4th- or 5th-grader, invite them to Fuse because "it's a great day to learn about Jesus."
