PRESENT POSITIONED, PAST-INFORMED, AND FUTURE-FOCUSED



The year 2000 marked the beginning of a new millennium and global reset. Anxiety was high that the Y2K bug – a flaw in existing computer systems – would crash systems globally when the calendar turned at the end of 1999. The relief when this technological catastrophe did not happen spurred massive technological growth and development. Developed economies maximized growth by focusing on digital innovation. Global trade, travel and communication accelerated along with unprecedented scientific breakthroughs, including the completion of the first draft of the human genome. Private investors cashed in, investing massively in internet-based companies that were as high on promise as on risk. With no guaranteed reward, the “dot.com boom” was unsustainable and the bubble burst eventually, leading to a stock market crash.

In the same year, on a personal level, Mary and I also took a leap of faith, leaving everything behind in England to start afresh in Atlanta, GA, with nothing but our young family and a promise – that the God who was sending us to a strange land would be with us every step of the way. In retrospect, our arrival in sunny Georgia was similar in many ways to Noah stepping out of the ark in Genesis 8 – everything he knew had changed. Nothing was familiar. A world of endless possibilities lay before him with one common denominator –whatever he chose to do, he would have to start from scratch. My sentiments exactly when we arrived in Atlanta, but also my situation. Enough people feared that the move was destined for a crash landing from the get-go. There was no going back – we’d given up all we had with nothing to fall back on. Our present reality was harsh – we knew no one and had next to nothing; and the forecast on the future was bleak. Yet look at what GOD has done.

Today, as a church family, our collective history dates back a quarter of a century. I stand in awe of this great God. As someone with the humble privilege of leading this Great Assembly, I also recognize that part of our story, is done. To successfully write the chapters ahead, correct the mistakes we made along the way, and face new challenges head on with the benefit not just of years lived, but of experience gained, we need to be keenly perceptive in three key areas – Hindsight, Insight, and Foresight. We must be skilful at distilling lessons from the past, to understand the present, and inform the future. As we stand at the crossroads of history and legacy, my reflections are focused on the three dimensions of life where human activity is captured: the Past, the Present, and the Future.

LOOKING BACK – REFLECTION:

History is the vault of the past. A proper understanding of history is foundational to anything a people can hope to do today or to be tomorrow. A people who do not know their history will struggle to understand their identity and will lack the confidence it takes to fulfill their God-given purpose. I look back at the past 25 years with gratitude to God for the journey that has led us here – people have been saved, healed, and delivered, and lives have been changed as they've encountered Jesus Christ. There have been mountain top experiences, and we've had our share of valleys. Nonetheless, I consider our history from a posture of intentional reflection. I look back at where we started, I see how far we've come, and I am grateful for where we are today.

LOOKING UP – ADORATION:

Speaking of where we are today – the present – my posture is one of intentional adoration. It is easy to be living the reality you prayed for and yet be distracted by what should not have happened, or by what hasn't happened yet. You can miss present opportunities by being too drained by the mistakes of the past, or too drunk on ambition for the future. The present is our moment in hand to pause and reflect on God's goodness and give thanks for all He's done – for our church family, for those who came, stayed, and even those who left. Our story would not be the same without the experiences that led us here and positioned us for a better tomorrow.

LOOKING FORWARD – EXPECTATION:

Today is the tomorrow you spoke of yesterday. Time is an unending continuum, stopping for no one, and each of the actors have a finite role that must be executed in accordance with God's grand and exquisite Master Plan. The consciousness of time is top of mind as I carefully consider our past, remain grateful in the present, and look towards the future – with a posture of intentional expectation. I am focused on the next stage of the mission God has given us. For me, the future is about consolidating our legacy by investing intentionally in the next generation. While the race isn't over for the older generation, we should run with the mindset of handing over the baton and preparing the younger ones to go even further with the Mandate of our King. Like the generation Joshua raised, I believe the next generation is well able for the task ahead. We must call them to rise and place their hands in ours as we train them for the future. We must teach them servant leadership, where humility does not rob them of the courage to stand on the shoulders of giants, and to see further aided by the vision of those who have walked with God in the dignity of years.

We will most likely all not be here at the turn of the next millennium, if Jesus tarries. But this is as good a time as any to look back in reflection, look up to God in adoration, and look forward to the future He has ordained for us with great expectation. I am humbled to be on this journey with you and even after 25 years, I have tremendous hope that God is only getting started with us!

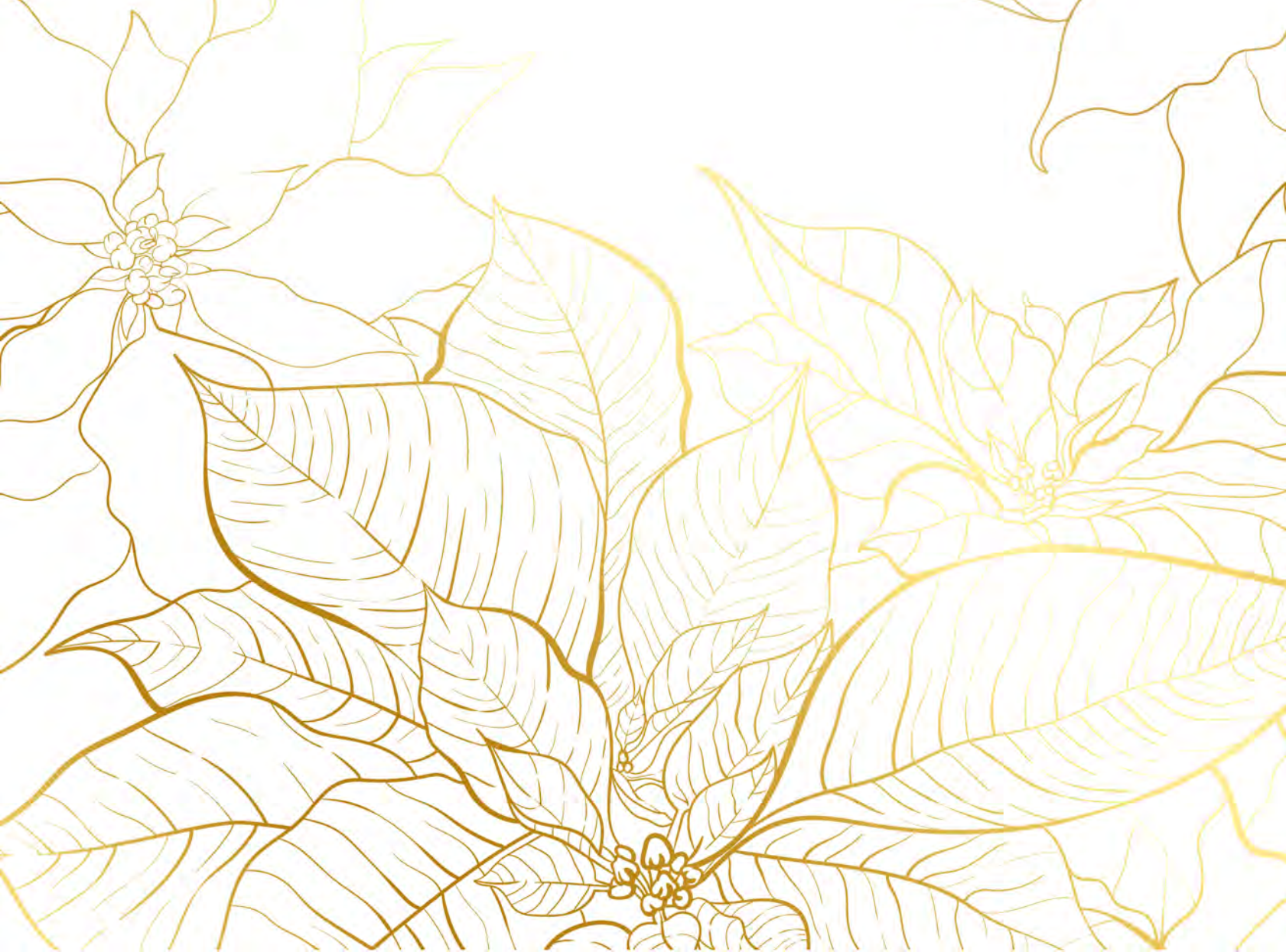

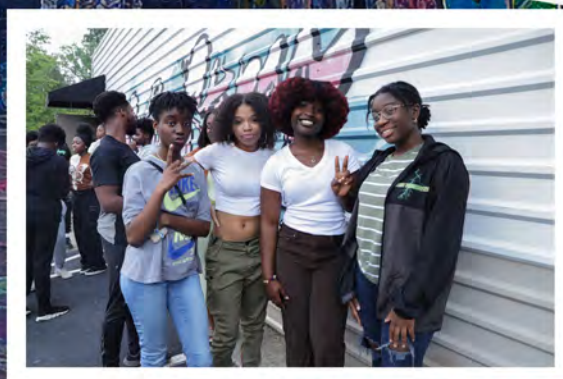
The future of the church is not someday—it's now. And it's alive in every worship set, every act of service, every bold prayer, and every life being transformed through Gennext.

For over two decades, All Nations Church Kharis House has stood as more than a place of worship in Gwinnett County, Georgia. It has become a beacon of compassion, service, and transformation—a spiritual home where destinies are shaped, God-connections are forged, and communities are uplifted.

REACHING BEYOND THE WALLS

Free screenings for blood pressure, diabetes, vision, and other essential services are provided to hundreds of families. For many, it's their only access to preventive healthcare.

In 2025, the event reached new heights. With record-breaking attendance, the Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners officially designated April as Discover Wellness Month, recognizing the lasting impact of Kharis House's commitment to community health.

“It's not just a health fair—it's a lifeline,” shared one attendee. “It gave me peace of mind and a plan for my health.”

EMPOWERING ENTREPRENEURS AND BUILDING WEALTH

Transformation at Kharis House is not limited to physical well-being—it extends to economic empowerment. During a leadership strategic retreat, a bold question emerged: What if we helped people not just survive—but thrive? The answer came in the form of a Business Fair that now draws aspiring entrepreneurs, small business owners, and corporate professionals across the region.

From humble beginnings, the fair has become an annual hub of opportunity—offering access to mentors, employers, branding experts, financial literacy coaches, and hands-on business development workshops. What began as inspiration has become a launchpad for dreams—helping attendees build businesses, shift career trajectories, and create a new narrative of generational wealth and financial stewardship.

THE ALL-NATIONS KHARIS HOUSE MEDIA STORY

Over the past 25 years, church media has experienced a remarkable evolution—one that has not only changed how congregations engage with faith, but also how the Church reaches the world. 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EB-2 NATIONAL INTEREST WAIVER (EB-2)- THE GOLDMINE FOR ADVANCED DEGREE HOLDERS.

The Employment-Based Immigration; Second Preference EB-2 (NIW) is undoubtedly a goldmine for advanced degree holders who have attained a significant number of years in their chosen field of career or believe they possess some exceptional ability in the sciences, arts, or business. The USCIS' issued data for fiscal year 2023 showed that the approval rate for EB-2 NIW was between 77 and 85%. The top five (5) countries with the correspondent approval were China-1,139, Brazil- 927, Iran 856, India 496, and Nigeria 461.

WHAT IS EB-2 NIW & WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE EB-2 NIW?

Generally, for all employment based visa petitions, the qualifying candidate must have a job offer in hand and undergo the labor certification process. However, under the EB-2 NIW, an applicant petitions the USCIS to waive both requirements because their educational qualification, proposed endeavor based on their work is of substantial merit & of national importance to the USA and as such, it would be beneficial to the US to waive the requirements since the applicant is well positioned to advance the proposed endeavor.

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The NIW petition is the first step to secure a green card. With an approval from the NIW application, applicant must file an adjustment of status to get their work authorization and green card.

HERE ARE SOME BENEFITS FOR THE EB-2 NIW;

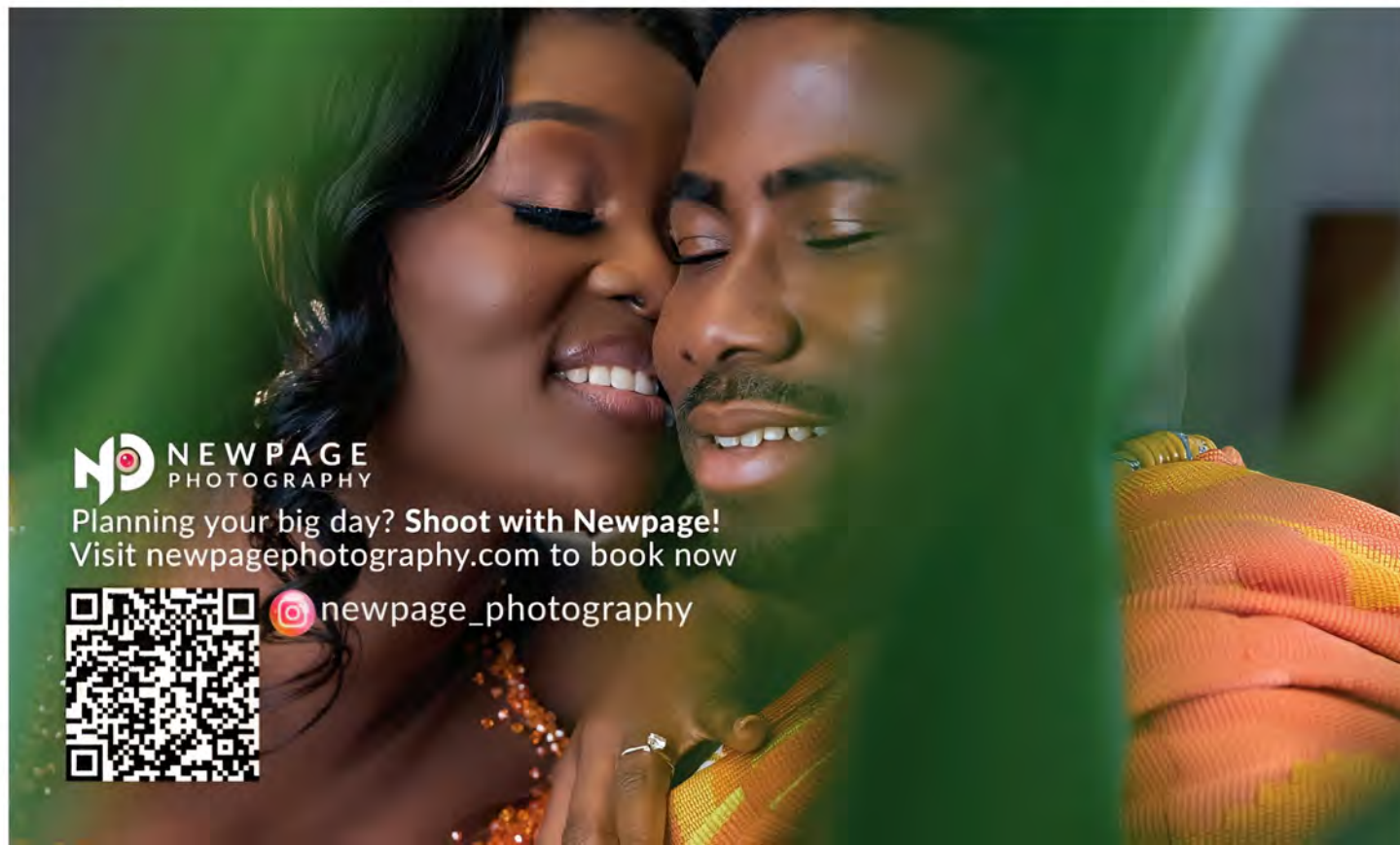
- Unlike other forms of immigration petition, the EB-2 NIW is a self-petition application. Applicants do not require an employer, and do not require a job offer.
- The EB-2 NIW offers an expedited processing where the USCIS guarantees a decision on your petition within 15 business days
- Unlike other employment- based categories, the EB-2 waives labor certification process.
