4. From verse 2, where is Carmel and what happens to it? Why is this so bad?
5. What does "for three transgressions and for four" mean?
6. What does "I will send a fire" mean?
7. In verse 5, what is the gate bar, and what did it do?
8. In verse 11, who is the "brother" mentioned?
