2. In verse 1, was King of Babylon Nebuchadnezzar partial to God?
3. In verses 1-2, why did God allow Nebuchadnezzar to capture Judah?
4. In verses 6-7, what did the new Babylonian names do to Daniel and his friends' old names?
5. In verse 8, why did Daniel not want to eat the "king's delicacies"?
6. In verses 8-13, how did Daniel and his friends resist the Babylonian food commands?
7. In verses 9-16, how did God show special treatment to Daniel and his friends?
8. What does name Daniel mean?
9. What other books of the Bible reference Daniel the prophet?
10. Who prophesied about Babylon taking the Jews captive?
11. Do you think that Daniel was an eunuch?
