4. In verses 25-26, what happened between the Kings of the North and South?
5. In verses 28-31, what happened in Israel as Antiochus IV Epiphanes returned from Egypt?
6. In verse 30, who did the “ships of Kittim” represent?
7. In verse 31, what was “the abomination of desolation”?
8. In verses 32-35, what things happened among the Jews when Antiochus IV Epiphanes defiled the temple?
