Additional
questions:

1. In verses 12-13, why did the advisors describe Daniel as a Jewish exile to the king?
2. In verses 14 and 18, what was the king's reaction to Daniel going into the lions' den? What do you think he tried to do to deliver Daniel?
3. In verses 16 and 19, who did the kings think could rescue Daniel?
4. In verse 17, why do you think a sealed stone was needed and not just guards?
5. In verse 24, what did the king do to those who had falsely accused Daniel? Why were their entire families involved?
6. In verses 25-27, do you think we will see King Darius in heaven?
7. In verse 28, how do think that Daniel "prospered"?
