

Read Daniel 9:1-19 and answer questions 1-6 on pages 143-144 in Be Resolute book.

Additional questions:

1. In verses 1-2, Jeremiah prophesied the 70 years of Jerusalem's desolations.

Read 2 Chronicles 36:20-21, Jeremiah 25:11-12, and Jeremiah 29:10.

2. In verses 1-2, how do you think the 70 years are to be measured?

3. Daniel's great prayer is in verses 4-19. What was he praying?

4. Also in those verses, why did Daniel first use the name Lord or Yahweh for God?

5. In verse 11, what are the "curse and oath"?

Read Leviticus 26:33-34.

6. In verse 15, why does Daniel refer to "out of Egypt"?

7. In verse 18, Daniel points out God's great mercy, not what the people have done. What does this remind you of?

8. In verse 19, why is Daniel asking God to take action now that the 70 years are passing?

9. Why did God send the Jews into captivity?
