

Read Ezra 10:1-19 and 44, and answer questions 5-6 and 9-11 on page 69-70 in the Be Heroic book.

Additional questions:

1. In verse 1, why do you think the people gathered around Ezra when he was confessing the sin of Israel to God?
2. In verses 2-3, what is proposed to handle the sin of marrying foreign women?
3. In verse 3, why did they make a covenant with God, not just a promise?
4. Is verse 4 a concern about Ezra's resolve?
5. In verses 7-8, what is the penalty for failing to assemble at Jerusalem as proclaimed?
6. In verses 7-8, where do you think that the confiscated property goes?
7. In verses 12-14, why did the people ask to leave Jerusalem and go to their own towns?
8. In verses 12-14, what is proposed in response?
9. In verse 15, what do you think happened to the men who objected to Ezra's plan?
