Read Micah 4-5 and answer questions 6-10 on page 127-128 in the Be Concerned book.

Additional questions:

1. What are God's four promises in chapter 4 and 5:1-5a?
2. What does "latter days" mean in verse 4:1?
3. In 4:2, what does "we shall walk in His paths" mean to you?
4. In 4:4, what does "sit under His vine and fig tree" say to you?
5. In 4:13, what is your understanding of "arise and thresh"?
6. What do the "horn" and "hoofs" symbolize in 4:13?
7. Compare the "strike" in 5:1 to Mark 15:19. Is this the same reference?
8. Why is "from everlasting" very important in 5:2?
9. What do we learn about the Messiah in 5:1-5a?
10. What will happen to Israel in 5:5b-15?
11. In 5:7-9, what do you see in the description of the Israelites?

Homework for November 12, 2023: Read Micah chapter 6 and pages 129-135 in the Be Concerned book by Wiersbe. Answer questions 1-5 and 8 on pages 140-141.
