5. In verses 6-9, why were the Jewish exiles in Babylon to return to Jerusalem?
6. In verse 8, what kind of a "touch" is referenced to here?
7. In verse 10, why is God using the term "O daughter of Zion"?
8. In verse 11, what is God talking about with "many nations" and "My people"?
