

Leader: Listen, friends - God is always speaking: stay ready to listen, prepare for action, dress in love and compassion.


People: God comes at unexpected times, in unexpected places; we want to be ready to say, "Yes!"

We believe in God: who has created and ins creating, who has come in Jesus the Word made flesh, to reconcile and make new, who works in us and others by the Spirit. We trust in God.






