SCRIPTURE

GENESIS 16:1-6, 17:1-8

Read Genesis 16:1-6 and discuss 1-2 of these questions:

- Why do you think Abram and Sarai stopped trusting in God's plan?
- Why does it seem like God makes us wait so much?

Read Genesis 17:1-3a and discuss 1-2 of these questions:

- Why does God tell Abram, "walk before me and be blameless" (Gen. 17:1)?
- Why would God still use us if we let him down?
- How can Abram and Sarai's story give us hope?

Read Genesis 17:3b-8 and discuss 1-2 of these questions:

- How can we know God is calling us into a covenant with him?
- How can Abraham's story help us in our walk with Christ?

CONNECTION

How can you grow in your faith while going through a difficult time?
