MIDDLE SCHOOL-Small Group Lesson #3 "Be Known For Making Him Known"

Summary (KEY TEXT Genesis 11: 1-9)

• Tonight's lesson on the Tower of Babel showed that the people wanted to make a name for themselves instead of honoring God. Their pride led to confusion and separation when God scattered them across the earth. God calls us to be known for making Him known—living in a way that points others to His greatness, not our own. When we seek His glory above ours, we find true purpose and unity in Him.

HIGH SCHOOL—Large Group Lesson "Faithfulness of God"

Summary (KEY TEXT Genesis 12 & 15)

• Pastor Cam's lesson from Genesis 12 and 15 highlighted God's faithfulness through His covenant with Abraham. By grace, God chose Abraham and promised him land, descendants, and blessing—revealing His plan to save humanity through faith, not works. Abraham's belief was credited as righteousness, showing that salvation comes by grace through faith. This covenant reminds us that we are blessed to bless others and that even when we are unfaithful, God remains faithful and invites us to trust Him completely.
