### MIDDLE SCHOOL—Large Group Lesson “Sovereignty of God”

*Summary (KEY TEXT Genesis 37-50)*

- Pastor Charles' lesson covered a large portion of scripture from Genesis 37-50. Joseph's life shows that even when everything feels out of control—betrayal, slavery, prison, and pain—God is still completely sovereign (in full control) and working out His good plan. Joseph's story teaches us that we can trust God with our lives, our circumstances, and our future because nothing can stop His plan.

### HIGH SCHOOL-Small Group Lesson #4 “Testing Grows Faith”

*Summary (KEY TEXT Genesis 22vs1-3, 9-12, 15-17)*

- In the Bible, testing isn't about punishment—it's about growth. God tests Abraham by asking him to sacrifice his son Isaac, revealing whether Abraham truly trusts Him. Abraham obeys fully, showing a faith that chooses God even when the command is painful and confusing. Because Abraham proved his faith through obedience, God stops the sacrifice, affirms Abraham's trust, and powerfully renews His promise to bless him.
