

# 5.21.25 Small Group...Plan For the Night

- 7:00PM

- 7:40PM (approximately)
  - Small group time

    - HS 9<sup>th</sup> grade in lobby; 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade in Worship Center (feel free to meet outside if the weather is nice)
      - *Please send 2 people from your group to the lobby to pick up your pizza & bottled water*
    - Application activity in small groups (optional...see ideas below)

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**You will have approximately 45 minutes of small group time (while you are eating pizza) at the end of the evening. You can use this time for fellowship and/or to do an activity. Here are a few activity suggestions if you should need them:**

### **Summer Plans: 2 Truths And 1 Lie**

- Have each student/leader come up with 2 truths about what they will be doing this summer, and 1 lie about something they will NOT be doing this summer. One by one, have each person share these 2 truths & a lie and have the other students guess which one is the lie.

### **Shoe Look**

- Everyone sits in a circle and looks at their own shoes.
- Everyone counts 3-2-1 and then looks up and has to look at someone right away.
  - If 2 people make eye contact, they are eliminated, and the circle gets smaller.
- Keep repeating until almost everyone is out.

### **Summer Small Group Get-Together**

- Have your students brainstorm a summer small group get-together idea that THEY want to do and that THEY are willing to organize. (HINT: Some super easy get-together ideas are meeting up at South Pier Parlor and/or Eb Flo Coffeehouse!)
  - Encourage 1-2 students to agree to spearhead this get-together and be responsible for communicating the details to the rest of the group.
  - If possible, look at calendars and see if the group can pick a get-together date now before everyone scatters for the summer.
    - Plan a back-up activity to fall back on if the initial get-together idea is weather dependent, incase the weather doesn't cooperate.

### **Group Chat**

- If you do not already have one, create a group chat (Whatsapp is a great option for this...please do NOT use SnapChat) that the group can use to stay connected over the summer.
- Encourage your students to use this chat to...
  - Share prayer requests
  - Share Bible verses
  - Coordinate a time for everyone to meet up for ice cream, etc.
