Leadership Next Steps

LEAD A SMALL GROUP LESSON

- Prerequisite for leading a small group lesson
 - Leaders need to ensure that students who lead small group lessons are saved followers of Jesus with a proven pattern of behavior that would mirror that decision.
- Helping prepare a student to lead a small group lesson
 - Students should NOT be given free reign to lead a small group lesson without a small group leader helping them prepare and run through their lesson before it is taught; leaders, if you don't have time/interest to help prepare a student to teach & lead well then don't have him/her lead a lesson
 - It is a good 1st step to have a student co-lead a lesson with a small group leader before having him/her teach an entire lesson on their own
 - It is perfectly fine to pair up 2 students who want to co-lead a lesson
 - Give student(s) the small group lesson well in advance (4-6 weeks or more) so that he/she has plenty of time to look the lesson over and prepare
 - Schedule time to meet with the student (several weeks before they are set to lead) and have them run through their lesson so that you know they are prepared and that you can give them teaching pointers
- Follow up once a student has taught a small group lesson
 - Schedule time to give student feedback on how they did, what areas they did well with and where they can improve if they were given a chance to teach a lesson in the future.

RUSH WORSHIP TEAM
