Seeds and Things

Jesus says that faith the size of a mustard seed is enough to help God. Real seeds are beautiful and complex, just like faith. What do you know about seeds?

Some orchid seed-pods hold 3 million seeds.

Some seeds were found in frozen soil in Canada that were supposed to be more than 10,000 years old...and they still grew flowers!

Most oak trees don't grow their own seeds, or acorns, until they are at least 50 years old.

You probably eat seeds every day! Sunflower seeds on your salad, peanuts for a snack, beans with your dinner... seeds are everywhere in our food!

The outside of a seed is called a seed coat. It keeps the seeds protected and and healthy until they're ready to grow!

The inside meat of a seed is called cotyledon. It provides the seed with food while it's growing.

The third piece of a seed is called the embryo. This is where the actual plant starts growing from!
