Unity Lutheran Church (revised for November)

Unity will be a warming center every night from Nov. 24th thru Mar. 31st to provide shelter & comfort for the campers, especially families with children. This will increase need for clothing & food donations.

Clothing ministry: men's belts, men's jeans (waist 34" and lower), quilts, blankets, new underwear/ socks, shoes, shirts, sweaters, coats, boots, gloves, hygiene items (deodorant, foot powder, lotion, body wipes, toothpaste and toothbrushes).

Take-out meal ministry: the first Wed. of the month from 1–3 pm, to assemble bag lunches. Volunteer sheet is on the bulletin board.

Food pantry: white rice, canned pasta/chicken/tuna, Triscuits, pkg of fruit cups (apple sauce, peaches, pears), chicken soup, Knorr side dishes (rice/noodle), canned potatoes/pasta/mushrooms, olives (ripe/ stuffed), condiments (ketchup/mustard/mayo). Food & clothing donations will be delivered **Tuesday, Nov. 18th.**

CommUNITY meal: the next hot meal is **Wednesday, Nov. 19th.** Volunteer sign-up sheet is on the bulletin board for meal prep, meal serve, fellowship and clean-up. There is a need for more clean-up volunteers in the 6:30 – 7:30 pm time slot.

Thanksgiving, Nov 27th : Thanksgiving meal will be served in early afternoon. Volunteers to prepare and serve the meal are welcomed. More details will be in future yellow pages as they become known.
