Thank you for jumping in on Ridgepoint's 2024 Bible Reading Plan!

This plan offers the choice of a **"feast,"** a **"meal,"** or a **"snack."**

The **"feast"** will take you through the whole Bible in a year, plus the Gospels and Romans twice (a commitment of 10-15 minutes/day). The **"meal"** will take you through the New Testament in a year, plus the Gospels and Romans twice (a commitment of 5-6 minutes/day). Both of these plans are available online through the YouVersion app. Sign up and get instructions at ridgepointwichita.com/bible.

The **"snack"** is one verse each day. This book is primarily for those who are choosing the "snack" schedule because it is not available online or through the YouVersion app.

If you are reading through the whole Bible or the New Testament, please consider following those plans through the YouVersion app. This will allow you to make comments on particular verses and read the comments of others.

Your daily "snack" will be greatly enhanced if you not only read the verse(s) for the day, but copy them in this book and then pray them.

For example, the Day 1 reading is Genesis 1:1. After reading the verse, copy it in the space provided and pray that verse. You might pray something like this: "Father, thank You for being the all-powerful and creative God that You are. You made a beautiful earth for us to enjoy. As I benefit from Your creation, help me to remember that You are behind everything."

Please don't rush this, regardless of which reading schedule you follow! The Bible is a "lamp for your feet and a light for your path" (Psalm 119:105). Read it! Copy it! Pray it!

A couple other comments:

- The daily verses have been taken from either the NIV, ESV, or HCSB versions of the Bible.
- To understand the context of the daily verse, it will be helpful to read the verses before and after the verse of the day.

Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will.

Read, Copy, & Pray Proverbs 6:16-19

There are six things the LORD hates, seven that are detestable to Him: haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, a false witness who pours out lies and a person who stirs up conflict in the community.

Read, Copy, & Pray Matthew 5:16

Read, Copy, & Pray Matthew 8:16

When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to Jesus, and He drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick.

March 17

Read, Copy, & Pray Psalm 33:3-4

Sing a new song to Him; play skillfully on the strings, with a joyful shout.
For the word of the LORD is right, and all His work is trustworthy.

March 18

Read, Copy, & Pray Deuteronomy 2:7

The LORD your God has blessed you in all the work of your hands. He has watched over your journey through this vast wilderness. These forty years the LORD your God has been with you, and you have not lacked anything.

Matthew 11, Deuteronomy 3-4, Psalm 34

March 19

Read, Copy, & Pray Matthew 11:28-30

Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and my burden is light.

Matthew 12, Deuteronomy 5-6

March 20

Read, Copy, & Pray Deuteronomy 6:4-5

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

Day 81 Reading

Matthew 13, Deuteronomy 7-8, Psalm 35

March 21

Read, Copy, & Pray Deuteronomy 8:14

Be careful that your heart doesn't become proud and you forget the LORD your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the place of slavery.

Day 82 Reading

Matthew 14, Deuteronomy 9-10

March 22

Read, Copy, & Pray Deuteronomy 10:12-13

And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God ask of you but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in obedience to Him, to love Him, to serve the LORD your God with all your soul, and to observe the LORD's commands and decrees that I am giving you today for your own good?

Read, Copy, & Pray Psalm 36:5-6

March 26

Read, Copy, & Pray Deuteronomy 17:18-19

When he takes the throne of his kingdom, he is to write for himself on a scroll a copy of this law, taken from that of the Levitical priests. It is to be with him, and he is to read it all the days of his life so that he may learn to revere the LORD his God and follow carefully all the words of this law and these decrees.

Read, Copy, & Pray Deuteronomy 23:21

If you make a vow to the Lord your God, do not be slow to pay it, for the Lord your God will certainly demand it of you and you will be guilty of sin.

Matthew 22, Deuteronomy 25-26

March 30

Read, Copy, & Pray Matthew 22:37-40

Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

Read, Copy, & Pray Psalm 39:1

Read, Copy, & Pray Deuteronomy 30:19-20 *(write small!!)*
