Title: That I May Walk in Your Truth

Text: Psalm 86

Big Idea: As we see who our God is, it evokes a response.

1 Incline your ear, O LORD, and answer me, for I am poor and needy.

Preserve my life, for I am godly; save your servant, who trusts in you - you are my God.

Be gracious to me, O Lord, for to you do I cry all the day.

Gladden the soul of your servant, for to you, O Lord, do I lift up my soul.

For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving,abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you.

6 Give ear, O LORD, to my prayer; listen to my plea for grace.

7 In the day of my trouble I call upon you, for you answer me.

8 There is none like you among the gods, O Lord, nor are there any works like yours.

9 All the nations you have made shall come and worship before you, O Lord, and shall glorify your name.

10 For you are great and do wondrous things; you alone are God.

11 Teach me your way, O LORD, that I may walk in your truth; unite my heart to fear your name.

12 I give thanks to you, O Lord my God, with my whole heart, and I will glorify your name forever.

13 For great is your steadfast love toward me; you have delivered my soul from the depths of Sheol.

14 O God, insolent men have risen up against me; a band of ruthless men seeks my life, and they do not set you before them.

15 But you, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in **steadfast love** and faithfulness.

16 Turn to me and **be gracious to me**; give your strength to your **servant**, and **save** the son of your maidservant.

17 Show me a sign of your favor, that those who hate me may see and be put to shame.

Why study the psalms? That we might have h____ (Romans 15:4).

Outline (Stages or Plateaus)

Chiastic Structure: Similar verses are mirrored about a central verse or verses.

I. (1-4), (16-17) Our Base Camp/Foundation

(1) Incline - for God to bend down from heaven . . . poor and needy

(4) I lift up my soul . . . gladden my heart

(16 & 3) Be gracious to me

(17) A sign of your favor

 Recognize the Source of solutions to our biggest challenges is w/ God

II. (5), (15) Our God of Steadfast Love

God is merciful & gracious

-> Our confident hope in answered prayer is founded in knowing who God is

III. (6-7), (14) The Psalmist's Trial or Issue

-> David is more focused on who God is than what his trial is

IV. (8-10), (12-13) Our God's Power & Faithfulness

Past/future performance

All the nations shall worship you - will acknowledge who are

There is none like you

Steadfast love (hesed love)

-> Our confident hope in answered prayer is founded in knowing who God is

V. (11) The psalmist Responds

Psalmist's relationship moves toward God

Who is present at the summit

We need to respond to who our God has revealed himself to be Walk in your truth (The Truth)

David's response is to pray for his own faithfulness & growth.

-> Real Biblical truth can change the trajectory of your life

How can we grow? We can grow through prayer $3 \times 3 \times 30$ Prayer Challenge/Response

One Last Thing: Romans 8:32 = a sign that fortifies our hope
