The Council's Decree: A Church Guided by the Gospel Title:

Text: Acts 15:19-35 Date: June 15, 2025

-O- Big Idea

As Christians, we are to be both grounded in and guided by the gospel. Though, in Jesus, we are under grace and free from the law, nevertheless, we make ourselves servants of others in love.

1. Preliminary Observations

Observation #1: In Our Missionary Work, Theological Reflection Is As Important As Pioneering Action

This same church there in Antioch that sent Paul and Barnabas out on a pioneering mission to bring the gospel to the nations in Acts 13, is now sending them back to Jerusalem to clarify doctrinal matters here in Acts 15. May we never think that spending time getting our doctrine right, getting trained, or reading our Bibles is irrelevant, or at least not as important, when it comes to reaching the world for Jesus. Who cares that we're breaking new ground for the gospel if we've lost our grip on the truth of the gospel. We may be reaching the nations, but what are we reaching them with? They were "sent" in both directions-to the church and to the world, to the study and to the streetsbecause both are essential to the mission, critical to the health and progress of the whole endeavor.

Observation #2: In Our Fight for the Faith, the Manner Is As Important As the Matter

Here we learn, not just what we should fight for (i.e. the gospel!), but how we should fight for it: together, in community, under spiritual authority-guided not by our own faulty intuitions, but by God's Word, searching the Scriptures together.

2. Perplexing Recommendations

The love of God that comes to us freely by faith in Jesus starts to make us look more and more like Jesus. It melts the heart. It transforms the life. We are saved by grace and not by works, but when we truly take in that grace . . . it works. You're grounded in the gospel . . . and then *quided* by it.

"[Y]ou were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another." -Gal. 5:13

Expression #1: Moral Integrity

We're not going to live like the world. We're going to live like our God, like Jesus. He writes the law on our hearts by his Spirit.

Expression #2: Cultural Sensitivity

I don't think these explicit recommendations here by James about meat and all this are necessarily as relevant for us today in the specifics, but the principle of love as cultural sensitivity-giving up freedom in concern for others—that remains as relevant as ever.

A lot of times the big problem with our cultural collisions, whether at a broader or individual level, is we get stuck in the horizontal. We're thinking about us vs. them, me vs. you ... and we forget him. We forget to let in the vertical, to rip the roof off of our back-and-forth and see Jesus. When you see him, it changes everything. There's never been a person more free in all the world than Jesus. And yet, every step of the way, when he could have chosen to use his freedom to serve himself, he instead chooses to use it to serve others in love. If he loves me like that, how am I going to come in and fight with you about all this secondary stuff? I can be sensitive to your needs, your values, your struggles, your culture. Instead of flaunting my freedom against you, I can give up my freedom in love for you.

Reflection Questions

- Which do you feel you need to most work on personallybeing grounded in the gospel or guided by it? Explain. What can you do to take a step in the right direction this week?
- Have you ever been tempted to use your freedom in Christ "as an opportunity for the flesh" (Gal. 5:13)? What would it look like to instead use it to serve others in love? Get specific!
