# -O- Big Idea

Every election is deemed "the most important of our lifetime." Our country and our very lives are said to be hanging in the balance. If we're not careful, we can get swept up in the narratives and the noise. We can attach our ultimate hope and dread to earthly princes instead of the one heavenly King. Jesus is the only one worthy of such things. Whoever else you vote for on November fifth, cast your vote for him!

The apocalyptically-charged rhetoric that politicians sometimes use, seems often to be a calculated effort to capitalize on yours and my sense of existential instability and vulnerability. They are aware of the fact that just living in a fallen world is a frightening and threatening endeavor. We are tenuous beings. Our lives play out in the shadow of death. We are trying desperately to survive. And, if we are to survive, we know that means we must: first, properly identify the problem; and, second, properly identify the solution. Who's the villain? Who's the hero? Who's the devil? Who's the Christ? And many politicians are ready to step into that existential tension and sort the matter out for us. "He's the threat." "She's the threat." "I'm the savior." "Vote for me."

### (1) The Prince (or where not to attach your ultimate hope and dread)

"Do not call conspiracy all that this people calls conspiracy, and do not fear what they fear, nor be in dread. But the LORD of hosts, him you shall honor as holy. Let him be your fear, and let him be your dread" (Isa. 8:12-13).

## (2) The LORD (or where to attach your ultimate hope and dread)

#### Observation #1: Both Sides of the Political Spectrum Are Represented

"In our political context, people on the Right and Left tend to emphasize different aspects of the government's work of dispensing justice. People on the Right tend to emphasize justice as righteously punishing wrongdoers, while people on the Left tend to emphasize lifting up the wronged. We believe the Bible emphasizes both (cf. Ps. 72:2, 4)" (Leeman and Naselli).

#### Observation #2: Both Sides of the Political Spectrum Only Come Toaether in Jesus!

If you look at that list the psalmist gave us there in vv. 7-9, it's pretty much an executive summary of Jesus' life and ministry, is it not? So on the one side, he cares for the oppressed and the poor. He extends a hand to the outcast and the marginalized. He feeds the hungry and heals the blind. He releases the prisoner. And yet, on the other side, we see that he also stands up for the law of God and orders his own life perfectly according to it. And we're told in the Scriptures that he's been appointed judge and, as such, he will ultimately bring the evildoer to ruin and right every wrong in the end. Don't you see? Both sides of the spectrum come wonderfully together in him. Love and truth. Grace and law. Mercy and justice. They are like two lines running side-by-side throughout the entirety of his life. And they converge and collide climactically in his death for us at the cross. That's where we see with crystal clarity, in one and the same glance, how it is that a holy God can both uphold justice and extend mercy to a lawbreaking sinner like me.

#### (3) The Choice

You might say this is the vote that really matters: Who will have my hope? Who will have my dread? Will I trust in God, fear God, praise God? Or will I give all that to someone else?



### **Reflection Questions**

- How do you feel about the upcoming election? Ecstatic? Afraid? Hopeful? Indifferent? Your feelings matter. They tell you something about where your heart is with God.
- Do you spend more time watching the news or reading your Bible? What effect do you think that's having on your soul (good/bad)? What (if anything) needs to change?
