This designated fund was developed by her family to provide support for our church, with priority given to the following programs:

- United Women of Faith (UWF) local projects and programs.
- Children and Youth Programs.

Mary Evelyn loved the beauty of the outdoors. She was a supportive participant in all things United Women of Faith, who, by pledge and promise, provide for women and children in many ways. The receptions, teas, bazaars, outings, mission programs 'of old' continue to be visions of joy and fellowship for those who knew her.
