For many of us, I'm afraid the Ten Commandments are not much more than a distant Sunday School memory from our childhood. Maybe we had to memorize and recite them, but they've never been connected to our present day view of who God is and how He would have us order our lives as His people.

For others, the Ten Commandments are nothing more than dusty Old Testament rules that are not relevant to our modern Christian culture. Yet the Ten Commandments are central to New Testament ethics in both the gospels (Mark 10) and the epistles (Romans 13). The Ten Commandments are as timeless as the Lord God who gave them.

Our problem with the Ten Commandments is not merely that they exist, but that we don't want anyone telling us what to do, including the God who created us.

But the reality is that (1) we are accountable to the God who created us and (2) the God who created us knows best how our lives should be ordered.

And the God who created us is the God who redeems us from sin. Our sin against Him. Our breaking of His commandments. Our rebellion against His rule. Our affront to His holy character.

The God who shook Mount Sinai with his fierce holiness when He gave the commandments shook Mount Calvary with his redeeming love when he delivered us from their judgment. If the Holy God of heaven brought you out of sin's bondage into his presence by his sacrificial love, the only logical and loving response is obedience – full, undivided allegiance to your God.

Join us this Fall as we consider the Ten Commandments and how they order our lives for God's glory and our joy.
