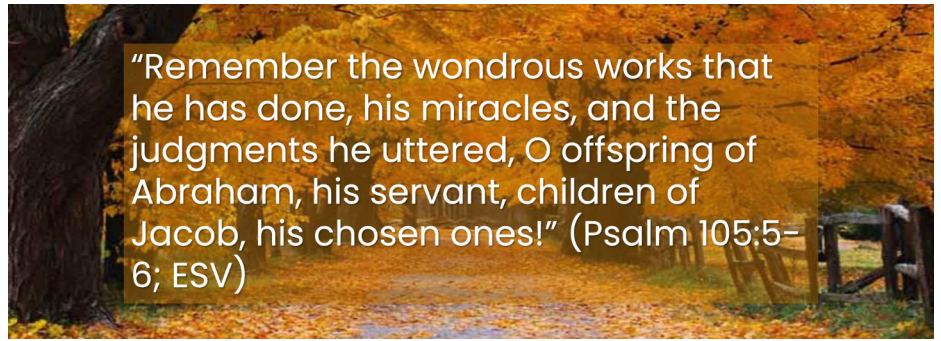

"Remember the wondrous works that he has done, his miracles, and the judgments he uttered, O offspring of Abraham, his servant, children of Jacob, his chosen ones!" (Psalm 105:5-6; ESV)

What works Abraham's descendants had to remember! Generations of lessons and experiences in God's faithfulness. The Psalmist records them in Psalm 105 so that the generations yet born might read and learn that...

God's promises do not fail when His purposes become unclear. Joseph, Jacob's son, son of the covenant, was sold into Egyptian bondage. And Egypt ain't Canaan. But when things go wrong, God is still in control. Egypt became the breeding ground for Canaan. Quietly, in a foreign land, the few who started the trek grew to outnumber their adversaries.

Feel like you're in Egypt? God is there with you. Growing you, strengthening you, raising you up to be stronger than your adversaries.

God's promises are kept in His own way. God turned the heart of the Egyptians to hate His people. Pharaoh's heart hardened time and time again. But if we were never faced with dire circumstances we would never experience dynamic deliverance. Remember, when things go wrong, God is still in control. Midnight darkness, bloody water, swarming frogs, hordes of flies, hail for rain, a veritable plethora of locust, and death to the first born proved that.

God still makes a way. God sent Moses to lead His people out of Egypt. And God still sends people into our lives to give direction, comfort, and provision. He still opens doors.

God's promises are always kept. When things go right, God is still in control. They all left Egypt. Pockets full. Feet dry. Enemy defeated. There is nothing quite so sweet as Divine deliverance. And since it was God who brought them out, who gave them food and drink, and who remembered His covenant with Abraham, the Psalm closes with these words, "Praise the Lord!" (ESV)

So don't let what you can't see keep you from praising God this Thanksgiving season. You may be in your own Egypt, but you are not alone. He is at work in your life for His glory and your good. He is the one who will bring you through.
