What is Kingdom Builders?

Kingdom Builders is a generosity initiative that helps accelerate the Kingdom of God by investing in local church expansion, global missions, and future Christian leaders. This end of the year campaign is a way for our Bethel family to give above and beyond our tithe to reach those who don't know Jesus worldwide. When you give to Kingdom Builders, your giving changes lives across the globe. Missionaries are equipped to reach people who have never heard the name of Jesus, children are saved from a life of being trafficked, and thousands experience miraculous healing. But it doesn't stop there. Your giving goes to local ministries across the country and right in our backyard.

Biblical Foundation

All throughout Scripture, you can see God's heart for the world and the nations. In fact, there are 1,600 Bible verses that show God's passion for the world. From Genesis to Revelation, God's desire is to make Himself known and show His love to all people on earth.

In John 3:16, it says, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only son." Christ's last words, known as the Great Commission in Matthew 28:18-20 can also be found in Acts 1:8. Jesus says, "You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

These words of Christ are our common mission as followers of Jesus. Our ultimate goal, found in Scripture, is depicted in Revelation 7:9-10, where it says that every tribe and nation would gather around the throne of Jesus, giving Him all of the praise and worship. Simply put, the aim of our mission is to see God's glory, and the gospel advanced among all the nations and people on earth, which includes the lost in our own local communities. If God's heart is for the world and the nations, are our hearts in alignment with His mission? As followers of Jesus, we should be on mission for Him so that all may know and worship Him.

Kingdom Impact

Here is a glimpse of your generosity:

In 2023, we set a goal of \$50,000, and we gave **\$54,515.21**. In 2024, we grew our goal to \$65,000, and through your generosity, we gave **\$78,349.59**. In two years, our church has generously given **\$132,864.80** towards Kingdom Builders. Since its start, **155** families and individuals have given.

Change The Map

In 2013, a small team of cross cultural workers in Southeast Asia began to dream big. They looked at a map filled with nations where Buddhism is the dominant faith and felt a holy burden. What if prayer could change this map? From that simple but powerful vision, Change the Map was born. Their mission is clear – to bring the love and hope of Jesus Christ to the Buddhist world through united and persistent prayer. Every week believers around the globe are joining in through Prayer Moments and online platforms like Twitter, Instagram, and Facebook. This movement reminds us that maps are not fixed. They can be redrawn when God's people pray. When we lift up Buddhist nations together, we are part of shifting spiritual landscapes and preparing the way for hearts to encounter Jesus.

Project Update

The year 2025 has marked an exciting new chapter for Change the Map. To reach even further, they launched a major renovation of their media center. The upgraded space is now equipped to produce high quality videos, podcasts, and digital resources that carry stories of hope, testimonies of transformation, and invitations to pray. This expansion is not only about better equipment; it is about amplifying the message so more people can hear, see, and respond. Every prayer warrior and financial partner has a hand in this, making it possible for the story of Jesus to spread more broadly across the Buddhist world. Together we are not only watching history unfold; we are shaping it. Through prayer and support, the map is being changed one life at a time.

The Unreached

More than 7,000 people groups in the world are considered unreached. Over 3 billion people live among the unreached. 42% of the world has yet to hear the Good News of Jesus. Of the 7,000 languages spoken around the world, about 125 million people do not have a single verse of Scripture translated into their language.

10/40 Window

A Geographic region of the world located between the 10 & 40 degrees latitude from West Africa to East Africa. 97% of the world's unreached people live in the 10/40 window. Home to Muslims, Hindus, Buddhists, and secular atheists. 68 countries across North Africa, Middle East, and Asia. Only 3.4% of missionaries serve here. The unequal distribution of the gospel of Jesus Christ is the greatest injustice on earth today. So much good work is being done, and we believe the best days to reach our world are still ahead of us.

Teen Challenge Cambodia – Visoth's Story



Visoth's life began in the streets of Cambodia, where survival was the only thing that mattered. Growing up, Visoth's father was a beggar, and his mother spent her days picking through trash and collecting recyclables. Life was hard, and love was not something Visoth knew. Instead, he learned how to survive—often from the streets, where friends introduced him to drugs at just 9 years old. The numbness they provided seemed like the only escape from the harsh reality he faced at home. As he sank deeper into addiction, Visoth felt even more lost.

One day, a teacher who saw the pain in his eyes reached out and brought him to Teen Challenge. That moment was the beginning of a radical transformation. For the first time in his life, Visoth encountered the love of Jesus.




Visoth upon entering Teen Challenge

Lonesome Dove

A Place of Hope

Lonesome Dove is a sanctuary for children who have faced some of life's hardest trials. Many come from the foster care system, carrying the weight of trauma, abuse, neglect, or abandonment. At the ranch, they discover something different: a place of safety, belonging, and hope. For 17 years, Lonesome Dove has been giving children life-changing experiences through camps and programs designed to restore joy and help them see a brighter future.

What We Do

- Children Served: Each year 300–350 children take part in our camps. No more than 50 per camp ensures personalized care.
- Volunteers: 600–850 volunteers join us annually, offering a 2:1 ratio of love, guidance, and attention.
- Ages: Camps serve kids ages 6-12, with new programs for teens 13-16 launching in 2025.
- Funding: 100% is privately supported by donors, businesses, and churches.
- Future: A long-term residential care program is being prepared, with the first homes expected by 2026.

How Healing Happens

Every part of Lonesome Dove is designed to restore what was broken:

- Equine Therapy: Horses help children build confidence and connection.
- Adventure Activities: From fishing to horseback riding, every activity creates joy and new memories.
- · Spiritual Support: Prayer and worship offer comfort, peace, and renewal.
- · Community and Care: Volunteers, counselors, and staff walk alongside each child with encouragement.
- · Family Support: Families are trained and prepared to adopt, fostering safe and loving homes.





Stories of IMPACT

Haley's Story

At just seven years old, Haley was found abandoned in a hotel room after enduring severe and unimaginable trauma, including sexual abuse and neglect. Removed from this dire situation, she arrived at Lonesome Dove Ranch scared and withdrawn. However, through the love and support of the ranch's community. Haley not only found her voice, but she also found new hope. By the end of her time at camp, she was connected with a foster family who would later adopt her and give her the forever family she had always longed for.



Braylon's Story

Braylon was a young camper who came to Lonesome Dove Ranch with the same story of brokenness and instability as other

children in the foster system. Over the year, he became a repeat camper, was adopted into a Christian home and began attending a local church.

Today, Braylon continues to give back. Now a freshman at Texas A&M University, he returns to the ranch to mentor other children as part of the staff, helping campers with Bible lessons and worship activities. Braylon's goal is to ensure other children experience the same healing and hope he found.



The Vision

Lonesome Dove is more than a camp. It is a movement of hope, faith, and healing. Here, forgotten children are reminded they are seen, loved, and created with purpose. Our vision is to keep expanding until every child who needs healing has a place to find it.

Sweet Grace Ministries

Finding Comfort through God's Sweet Grace

When we first learned that our baby would not make it, we were devastated. In the middle of our heartbreak, three different people from completely different parts of our lives all suggested Sweet Grace Ministries. Each of them said it was an incredible organization that could walk with us through such a painful season. That encouragement gave us the courage to reach out, and our first connection with them was through receiving a comfort bag.

From the very beginning, Sweet Grace surrounded us with compassion. For families experiencing early losses, they provide comfort bags, and for later losses, they send baskets and offer a photography ministry, giving families the only photos they will ever have with their babies, something that is truly priceless. After the initial care package, they invite parents into support groups where, month after month, we are able to connect with others who understand this unexplainable grief. Those groups have helped us form deep friendships with people who truly "get it."



One of the most meaningful ways Sweet Grace has cared for us is through their card ministry. On Mother's Day, Father's Day, our baby's birthday, and at Christmas, we receive a handwritten card. Those notes come on the hardest days and remind us that our baby's memory is alive and honored.

I still remember the moment our comfort bag arrived. It was heartbreaking to open, yet so healing. Inside were prayers, books, pamphlets, baby-related items, bracelets, and small personal touches that showed just how deeply they cared for and guided us with helpful resources. Sweet Grace has also supported both my husband and me in our unique ways of grieving. We have walked through this loss differently, but they've reminded us that there is no "wrong" way to grieve. Their support groups have given both moms and dads a place to hear one another's stories and find encouragement.

Because Sweet Grace is a Christian ministry, their presence in our darkest valley was a powerful reminder that God never leaves us. Their support has helped me find strength in my faith, even in the hardest moments. They have also helped me embrace my motherhood with confidence. Though it looks different than I imagined, they remind me that my baby, Jayce, did exist, even if it was only for 8 weeks & 4 days, and that I do not have to remember him alone.

Looking back, I realize one of the most impactful parts of their ministry is how they affirm that every life, no matter how brief, is valuable and worthy of remembrance. In a world where early loss is often dismissed, Sweet Grace boldly says the opposite: these lives matter, are deeply loved, and it is okay to grieve what could have been.

Sweet Grace Ministries has truly changed our lives. They meet families at their lowest point and continue to walk with them for as long as they are needed. Too many parents walk through pregnancy and infant loss alone, but with Sweet Grace, no one has to walk alone.

Experiencing Beauty in the Ashes

Every year, Sweet Grace Ministries witnesses moments of both deep sorrow and incredible healing. Because we walk daily with families in grief, we also get to see powerful stories of redemption—proof that beauty can truly rise from the ashes.

One recent story came from our annual Sweet Grace Walk. After the event, a family reached out to share how profoundly it had impacted their mother—the grandmother of a baby who had passed away. In her grief, she had lost all sense of hope and had turned to alcohol to cope. But something changed that day.

After listening to the story shared at the walk, she told her family she could finally see light again—a glimpse of hope and a way forward. She has since stopped drinking and is taking steps toward healing. In our support groups, we see this same transformation take place week after week. Parents arrive unable to speak through their pain, but months later they are the ones lifting others up—offering compassion and encouragement to those who are just beginning their journey.

Sweet Grace Ministries has always been about showing the love of Jesus through grace, compassion, and community. Our prayer is that through the care of our volunteers and staff, families will see Him in the middle of their grief.

In 2025, we have seen this prayer answered time and time again. We are deeply grateful.

He stepped boldly into ministry without the worry of debt and is making a lasting impact on lives for eternity.







Impact Teams

God is working powerfully through our students as they share the message of Jesus with others. Lives are being transformed as they embrace their callings and use their gifts to make a difference. They are building a strong spiritual foundation that will shape future leaders to further the Gospel.

Hands-on opportunities for Ministry

- Student ministry teams travel to churches spanning from New Brunswick, Canada, down through Maryland, and even as far as Ohio. All 77 students are placed at one of up to 17 partner churches, where they make an IMPACT in diverse environments such as recovery homes, inner-city outreach, and new church development.
- Students regularly participate in "3-for-10" preaching, where three students each deliver a message for 10 minutes in various locations throughout Maine.
- Every student selects a spirit-filled home church outside of the Charleston area, and each Sunday leads their specialty of ministry: children's education, musical worship, serving hospitality, and multimedia needs.



Current Work

We are dedicated to fostering both the spiritual and practical growth of our students. This year, we have enrolled 77 students, marking an 11.5% increase from the previous year. Our top priority for this year is to improve the conditions and availability of dormitory space to better accommodate our rapidly growing student body. As we anticipate continued growth, we are preparing to exceed our current housing capacity soon. Through this expansion, we continue to witness transformations and salvations among FBCI students, thanks to their obedience and service.

This year presented significant financial challenges, but also remarkable provisions. In response to a substantial financial need, our team prayed, and God answered with a \$250,000 Miracle Match from a generous donor. Their gift inspired others to contribute as well, resulting in over \$300,000 raised—surpassing our initial goal. This story is a testament to God's faithfulness and the power of community support.

Future & Needs

To sustain our growth and ensure that students can continue to be trained effectively for ministry, several key infrastructure and funding priorities must be addressed, including a new well and water supply, boiler, plow truck, and a debt-free ministry.
