**— Below are questions to help further our understanding of today's sermon. —**

1. How has prosperity in your own life affected your relationship with God, and in what ways can we guard against forgetting Him when we experience success?
2. What does it mean to have 'no other gods' before the one true God in our modern context, and how can we identify and remove idols in our lives?
3. How can we, as individuals and as a society, return to the foundational principles that the sermon suggests America was built upon?
4. In what ways does Peter's initial reluctance and subsequent obedience to Jesus' fishing instruction challenge you in your own walk of faith?
5. How does Jesus' miraculous catch of fish demonstrate His divine power and knowledge, and what implications does this have for trusting Him in our daily lives?
6. What can we learn from Peter's reaction to the miracle, falling at Jesus' knees and declaring his sinfulness?
7. How does the concept of being 'fishers of men' apply to our lives today, and what might it look like to leave everything and follow Jesus in our current context?
8. In what ways does Jesus' healing of the leper challenge societal norms and religious traditions, and how can we follow His example in reaching out to the marginalized?
9. Why do you think Jesus often withdrew to desolate places to pray, and how can we incorporate this practice into our busy lives?
10. What does it mean to be 'branded' as Christ's disciple in today's world, and how can we live out this identity boldly in the face of potential opposition?
