1. How can we practically love our enemies and do good to those who hate us in today's polarized world?
2. What specific actions can we take to embody this challenging teaching of Jesus?
3. In what ways might our judgments of others reveal the 'logs' in our own eyes?
4. How can we cultivate greater self-awareness and humility in our interactions with others?
5. Jesus speaks about being 'fruit inspectors' - how can we assess the fruit in our own lives and in the lives of others without falling into judgmentalism?
6. What does it mean to build our lives on the 'rock' of Christ's teachings?
7. How can we ensure our spiritual foundation is solid enough to withstand life's storms?
8. How does the concept of 'expecting nothing in return' when we give or lend challenge our typical motivations? In what ways might this attitude transform our relationships and communities?
9. Jesus warns about the blind leading the blind - how can we ensure we are following trustworthy spiritual guidance and not leading others astray ourselves?
10. What is the relationship between hearing Jesus' words and doing them?
11. Why might someone call Jesus 'Lord' but not follow His teachings?
12. How does the parable of the two house builders relate to the importance of not just hearing, but applying spiritual truths in our lives?
13. In what ways does our speech reveal the condition of our hearts, as Jesus suggests?
14. How can we cultivate hearts that produce good 'treasure'?
15. How might Jesus' teachings on love, judgment, and obedience challenge or contrast with popular cultural values today?
