

DAY 15

Prayer emphasis: **mental health** needs in the community

Start with Scripture: “You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you. (Isa 26:3)

DAY 16

Prayer emphasis: **youth** particularly those lacking good supports

Start with Scripture: “Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength.” (Isa 40:30)

DAY 17

Prayer emphasis: **seniors**, particularly those who live in isolation

Start with Scripture: “Even to your old age and gray hairs I am He, I am He who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you.” (Isa 46:4)

DAY 18

Prayer emphasis: individuals dealing with/healing from **abuse**

Start with Scripture: “The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.” (Ps 34:18)

DAY 19

Prayer emphasis: **teachers/parents** investing in the next generation

Start with Scripture: “Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. (Gal 6:9)

DAY 20

Prayer emphasis: **veterans/others** navigating systemic challenges

Start with Scripture: “I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will console you with my loving eye on you. (Ps 32:8)

DAY 21

Prayer emphasis: **working adults** who feel tired and distracted

Start with Scripture: “But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness and all these things will be given to you as well.” (Matt 6:33)

DAY 1

Prayer emphasis: reflect on the **magnitude** of God's Kingdom
Start with Scripture: "Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever! Amen." (Eph 3:20-21)

DAY 2

Prayer emphasis: look for the Spirit's **guidance** in everyday life
Start with Scripture: "Teach me to do your will, for you are my God; may your good Spirit lead me on level ground." (Ps 143:10)

DAY 3

Prayer emphasis: marvel at the superior eternal **wisdom** of God
Start with Scripture: "Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable His judgments, and His paths beyond tracing out!" (Rom 11:33)

DAY 4

Prayer emphasis: praise God for the **new life** available in Christ
Start with Scripture: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" (2 Cor 5:17)

DAY 5

Prayer emphasis: trust the Spirit's **dominance** over the enemy
Start with Scripture: "The [Spirit] who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world." (1 John 4:4)

DAY 6

Prayer emphasis: celebrate God for the daily renewal of His **mercy**
Start with Scripture: "His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." (Lam 3:22-23)

DAY 7

Prayer emphasis: admire God's **patience** so all might turn to Him
Start with Scripture: "The Lord is...patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance." (2 Peter 3:9)

Love One Another

DAY 8

Prayer emphasis: for moments to speak **gospel** truth to others
Start with Scripture: "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved...And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?" (Rom 10:13-14)

DAY 9

Prayer emphasis: that our **love** for one another would be obvious
Start with Scripture: "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." (John 13:35)

DAY 10

Prayer emphasis: growth into deeper **spiritual maturity** as a body
Start with Scripture: "Speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of Him who is the head, that is Christ." (Eph 4:15)

DAY 11

Prayer emphasis: for greater **unity** among God's people.
Start with Scripture: "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!" (Psalm 133:1)

DAY 12

Prayer emphasis: to **trust** God's work despite our lack of perfection
Start with Scripture: "Being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." (Phil 1:6)

DAY 13

Prayer emphasis: investment in the **next generation** of believers
Start with Scripture: "These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children." (Deut 6:6)

DAY 14

Prayer emphasis: pathways to **build relationships** with the lost
Start with Scripture: "Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity." (Col 4:5)
