

## STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

**Good News U** is a school for the training of the Five Fold Ministry. It is both assumed and expected that our students will not participate in activities which are contrary to the highest Biblical standards.

Behaviours which involve the use of foul language, "clubbing," sexually suggestive dancing, frequenting bars, alcohol of any form, tobacco, vaping, abuse of non-prescription drugs, pornography, erotica, gambling, sexual relationships outside of marriage, stealing, lying or cheating would be viewed as a serious breach of Christian standards and ministerial commitment.

For any second or third year students approved to be involved in romantic relationships, whether dating or engaged, a proper Christian lifestyle should be reflected. Traveling with your significant other, any overnight accommodations or living for any amount of time under the same roof is not appropriate. Dating in secret or initiating informal or undefined relationships outside of the outlined GNU policy would also be considered a breach of conduct.

All students are expected to operate with financial, legal and ethical integrity. All students are expected to adhere to the GNU dresscode. Ministerial misconduct or a violation of the ministering policy would also be considered a breach of conduct.

Any extent of involvement in any of the behaviours mentioned above, as well as others deemed inappropriate and made known to be as such by the administration at any time, would oblige the school administration to implement disciplinary action on the student, including possible expulsion.

These rules shall apply at all times during which the student is under the purview of the school in any capacity.

Students who have experienced past addictions may seek counseling onsite or be referred to an off-site counselor if the need is expressed.

In addition, it is both assumed and expected that our students view their enrollment at GNU as a privilege, and therefore will submit to all procedures, policies, rules, attitudes, and processes as outlined in the student handbook. Students' social media presence is viewed as an extension of their person and life and is subject to the conduct herin outlined.

As students training for the ministry, there is an expectation that there will be a desire to attend, invest in and serve in Good News Chapel services, events and its people; meeting program requirements as well as going above and beyond to reflect the servant leadership of Jesus Christ.

An attitude of respect and submission will be displayed and maintained at all times towards all Good News Chapel staff and pastors, GNU instructors and administration, as well as peers and classmates.

## STUDENT PLEDGE

I understand the requirements of attendance, the standards of academics and the expectations of spiritual maturity placed on me as a GNU student. To the best of my abilities, with all diligence, I will seek to attain them. Should I require any exceptions due to extenuating circumstances, I commit to following the procedures outlined in the Student Handbook.
