Week 1 Spiritual Gifts

Key Scripture for the Week: Romans 12:4-8

Focus: God has uniquely gifted you to build His Church.

Day 1 – Romans 12:1-8 – *Gifts to me for the Body*

Day 2 – 1 Corinthians 12:4-31 – Many Gifts, One Spirit

Day 3 – 1 Peter 4:10-11 – Serving by God's Strength

Day 4 – Ephesians 4:11-16 – Equipped for Service

Day 5 – Matthew 25:14-30 – Parable of the Talents

Day 6 – 2 Timothy 1:6-7 – Fan into Flame Your Gift

Day 7 – Psalm 139:13-18 – God Made You for a Purpose

Devotional thought: Your gifts are not for comparison but for contribution. When you understand and use them, the body of Christ grows stronger.

Reflection: What gifts has God entrusted to you? How are you currently using them?

Prayer focus: Ask God to reveal and strengthen His gift in you for His glory.

Week 2 Temperament Type

Key Scripture for the Week: Psalm 139:1-16

Focus: God designed your personality to reflect His creativity and to serve one another.

Day 8 – Genesis 1:26-31 – Made in God's Image

Day 9 - Jeremiah 1:4-10 - Known Before Birth

Day 10 – Romans 12:9-21 – *Love in Action*

Day 11 – Proverbs 27:17 – Sharpening One Another

Day 12 – Galatians 5:22-26 – Fruit of the Spirit

Day 13 – Colossians 3:12-17 – Clothed in Holy Christlike Character

Day 14 - 1 Corinthians 13 - The Way of Love

Devotional thought: Your temperament is a gift, not a flaw. God can refine it for His purposes, shaping you into a vessel of His love.

Reflection: How has God used your unique personality to bless others?

Prayer focus: Ask God to refine your temperament so it reflects the fruit of the Spirit.

Week 3 Evangelism Style

Key Scripture for the Week: Matthew 28:18-20

Focus: Every believer is called to share the Gospel, but God has given you a unique approach.

- Day 16 Acts 1:6-11 Empowered to Witness
- Day 17 John 4:1-42 Jesus' Personal Approach
- Day 18 Acts 17:16-34 Paul's Intellectual Approach

- Day 20 1 Thessalonians 2:8 Sharing Life and the Gospel
- **Day 21** 2 Timothy 4:1-5 Do the Work of an Evangelist

Devotional thought: Evangelism is not one-size-fits-all. God uses your personality, story, and relationships to reach people only you can reach.

Reflection: Which evangelism style resonates most with you? How can you use it this week?

Prayer focus: Ask God for boldness, sensitivity, courage, and opportunities to share His love.

Week 4 Passion in Serving

Key Scripture for the Week: Colossians 3:23-24

Focus: Passion fuels perseverance. God plants a desire in your heart to serve where you can be most effective.

Day 23 – John 13:1-17 – *Serving Like Jesus*

Day 24 - Philippians 2:1-11 - Humility in Service

Day 25 – Isaiah 61:1-4 – Anointed to Bring Good News

Day 26 – 1 Corinthians 9:19-23 – All Things for the Gospel

Day 27 – Hebrews 10:23-25 – Encouraging One Another

Day 28 - 2 Timothy 1:6-14 - Guard the Gift Entrusted to You

Devotional thought: Passion often starts with a burden—something you can't stop thinking about because God has placed it on your heart.

Reflection: What ministry or cause stirs your heart the most? How can you step into it now? Who do you need to walk beside to learn how?

Prayer focus: Ask God to align your passion with His mission and open doors for service.
