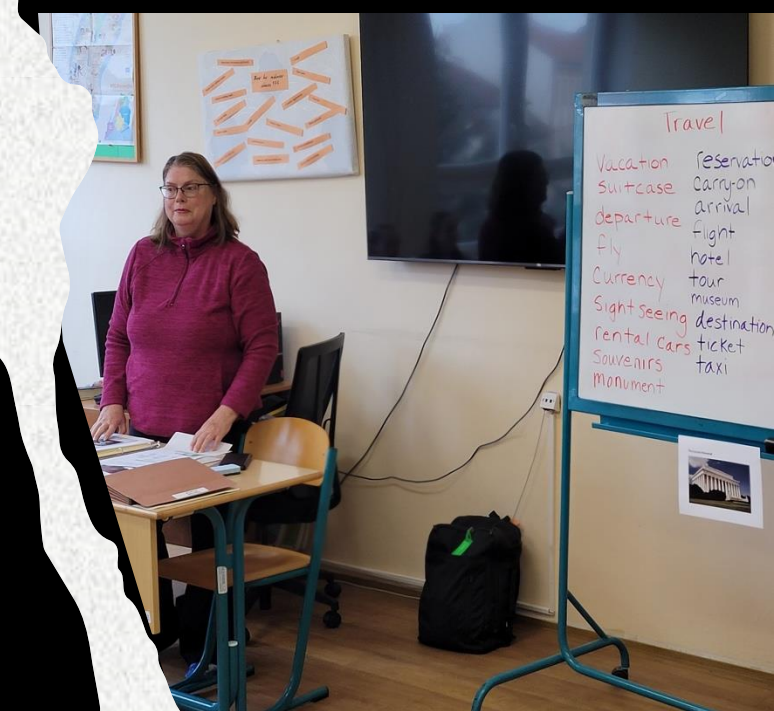
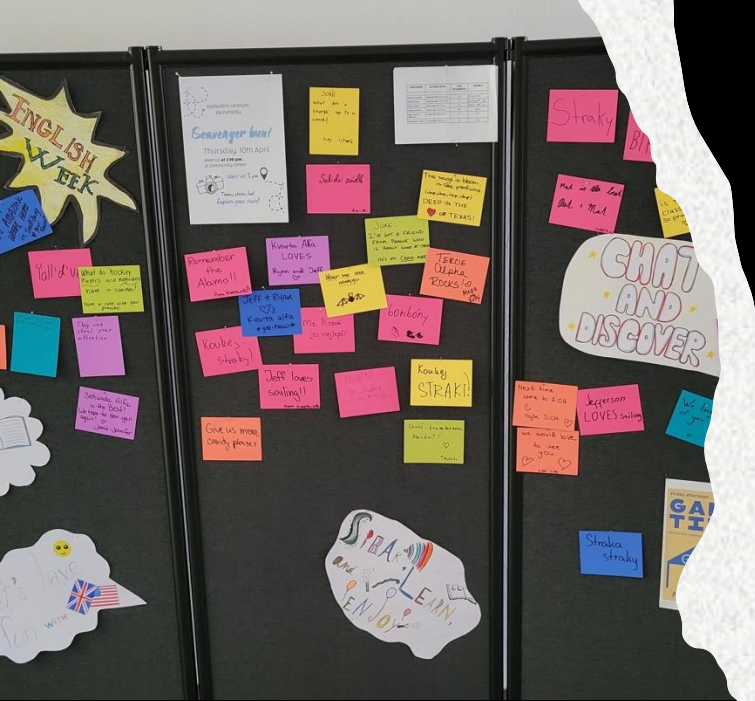

RELIGION IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC

THE CZECH REPUBLIC STANDS OUT IN THIS REPORT AS THE ONLY COUNTRY SURVEYED WHERE MOST ADULTS ARE RELIGIOUSLY UNAFFILIATED.

WHEN ASKED ABOUT THEIR RELIGION, 72% OF CZECH RESPONDENTS IDENTIFY AS ATHEIST, AGNOSTIC, OR "NOTHING IN PARTICULAR," AND ROUGHLY TWO-THIRDS (66%) SAY THEY DO NOT BELIEVE IN GOD.

GIVEN THAT OTHER COUNTRIES IN CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE EMERGED FROM A COMMUNIST RULE WITH MUCH HIGHER LEVELS OF RELIGIOUS AFFILIATION, THIS RAISES THE QUESTION: WHY AREN'T CZECHS MORE RELIGIOUS?

THIS GOES BACK AS FAR AS 1415, WHEN FOLLOWERS OF JAN HUS (HUSSITES),

A PRIEST IN BOHEMIA (NOW PART OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC), SEPARATED FROM THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

AFTER HUS WAS BURNED AT THE STAKE FOR HERESY.

AFTER THE THIRTY YEARS' WAR (1618 TO 1648), THIS BREAK FROM CATHOLICISM REVERSED ITSELF WHEN THE CATHOLIC AUSTRO-HUNGARIAN EMPIRE FIERCELY REPRESSED THE HUSSITES AND OTHER PROTESTANTS AND FORCIBLY RE-CATHOLICIZED THE AREA.

ANTICLERICALISM SURGED IN THE YEARS OF CZECH INDEPENDENCE AFTER WORLD WAR I, WITH THE COUNTRY'S CATHOLIC POPULATION DECLINING BY AN ESTIMATED 1.5 MILLION PEOPLE.

AFTER WORLD WAR I, THE SOVIET-INFLUENCED REGIME, WHICH WAS OFFICIALLY ATHEIST, FURTHERED THIS DISAFFILIATION. OPENNESS TO RELIGION BRIEFLY SPIKED AFTER THE FALL OF COMMUNISM, THOUGH EVIDENCE SUGGESTS THIS MAY HAVE BEEN MOSTLY A POLITICAL STATEMENT AGAINST THE COMMUNIST REGIME, AND SINCE THE EARLY 1990S, THE SHARE OF CZECHS WHO SAY THEY HAVE A RELIGIOUS AFFILIATION HAS DECLINED.

CBH IS PART OF THE APOSTOLIC CHURCH, WHICH IS DULY REGISTERED WITH THE MINISTRY OF CULTURE. WE HAVE BEEN OPERATING IN PRAGUE SINCE 2002. JESUS SUMMARIZED THE ENTIRE COMPLICATED JEWISH FAITH AND TRADITION INTO TWO COMMANDMENTS. LOVE GOD AND LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR.

THEIR VISION AND MISSION ARE SUMMARIZED IN THREE WORDS: "INTERVENE, PREPARE, AND RELEASE." WE BELIEVE THAT EVERY PERSON ON THIS PLANET IS CREATED BY GOD, PRECIOUS, UNIQUE, AND IMPORTANT. WE WANT EVERY PERSON ON THIS PLANET TO LEARN ABOUT THEIR CREATOR. IF EVERYONE IS IMPORTANT AND HAS A PLACE HERE, THEN WE WANT TO HELP EVERYONE REACH THEIR POTENTIAL. WE WANT TO HELP EVERYONE STEP INTO THEIR GIFTS. SO SIMPLY PUT: INTERVENE, PREPARE, AND RELEASE.

MATT AND PATTY HAVE ATTENDED CBH IN PRAGUE SINCE THEIR TIME IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC. WE WILL ATTEND CHURCH AT THE PRAGUE LOCATION.

THE CBH CHURCH IN SEDLČANY IS A SMALLER CHURCH PLANT, BUT IS WHO WE ARE PARTNERING WITH FOR THE ENGLISH WEEK.

Expectations

- You are held responsible to raise your own funds
- Ways to do this is through Writing letters of support (both for financial & prayer)
- We are a team. We will all travel to Costa Rica & back to Texas together
- Everyone will write letters of support for the prayer aspect of the trip even if you decided that you will personally fund the trip yourself.
- Attend our Training & Team Building Meetings
- Be ready to be Stretched and Uncomfortable
- Come Prepared with your completed Weekly Training Assignments
- Be ready to adapt on a moment's notice

Funds & Fundraising

- You are required to raise your own funds. A **\$250.00** deposit holds your spot on the mission trip.
- One of the best ways to raise funds is to write **support letters**. We will talk about how to do that at our first meeting.
- *With approved application, \$250 non-refundable deposit required.*
- **Deadline is July 26**
- *Within 2 months of departure, 50% of amount needed.*
- *Within 1 month of departure, 75% of amount needed.*
- *Within 2 weeks of departure, 85% of amount needed.*
- *Within 2 weeks of return, 100% of amount needed*
- In the event that you do not participate in the trip, any charges incurred on your behalf (airline fees, deposits, etc.) will be charged from your account, and you will be responsible for any deficit.
- *If this is your first mission trip, this organization helps with funding. You can apply using their application- www.thevessel.world*

1. Check your availability- **Friday, November 6 through Monday, November 15**
2. Fill out Frisco Bible Church Czech Mission Trip Mission Application:

3. Check to make sure you have a Valid Passport (cannot expire within the next 6 months) if you do not have a Passport, or it will expire within the next 6 months then expedite it- Do it now!
4. Attend our four Team Building/Training Meetings- Sunday afternoons 1:00-3:00 PM in Connections Center
6. Make a list of 50 people include in that list 25 people who do not attend FBC (family, friends, neighbors, co-workers, non-profit/board work)
7. Write out your “WHY” statement
8. Deadline for trip application is **Sunday, July 27th**
9. Prepare your heart for all that God will teach you
10. Immunizations are not required for this trip including COVID vaccine. Flu shot is recommended but not required.
