## **Knowledge**

Please write a rough draft of a plan of action for discipling your person to know the basics of what it means to properly navigate and understand the Word of God.

## **Holiness**

1. This is likely the most sensitive subject in all of discipleship. What do you think is an important way of helping your disciple open up about their sin struggles?
2. We looked over a long list of the “works of the flesh” and the “fruit of the Spirit” from Galatians 5. How do you plan on helping your disciple to understand how to walk by the Spirit?
3. Most of us have a few of those “works of the flesh” that we may struggle with now. How have you implemented the grace of God to overcome that sin daily?
4. What sort of disciplines do you plan on promoting in your discipleship manual, and why do you find those disciplines most beneficial?

## **Faithfulness**

1. There are examples of faithful people in the Bible as well as in your church. What do those faithful people have in common, and how will you communicate that to your disciple?
2. What are some ways you might convey the importance of faith to your disciple?
3. What sort of standard with you use to measure their faithfulness with?
4. Please describe a caricature of a person you would consider faithful.
5. What story could you tell your disciple to share when you became more faithful?

## In General

1. What kind of person do you think you might be able to disciple best? Would you rather disciple one person or several? How old are they? What kind of work do they do? Where are they in life? Are they married? Did they have good parents? What sort of background do they have?
2. When might you recommend that discipleship be terminated?
3. What are the bare minimum requirements (if any) for your disciple to start with?
4. How long do you predict it will take to finish a basic discipleship plan with someone who has everything to learn?
5. Of the first 4 milestones, which one is your strongest subject, and which is your weakest?
6. Given the choice between sharing the Gospel with friends, family, strangers, or acquaintances, which group is the one that you share the Gospel with the most?
7. How do you plan on discipling your person to share the Gospel?
