Abraham	His prophecies included the Lord on the Mt. of Olives
Ishmael	Abraham’s first son
Jacob	This person was handy with a tent spike
Judah	He was the first King of Israel
Rahab	He walked with God right into heaven
David	First man ever made
Jael	This king was promised an everlasting kingdom
Zechariah	She was the mother of Abraham’s first son
Joshua	God promised this man the land of Canaan
Joseph	He wrote the first 5 books of the Bible
Ruth	His offering was consumed by fire, but Baal’s offering was not
Hezekiah	He drove his chariot like a madman
Rehoboam	This man was the patriarch of the monarch (kingly) tribe
Daniel	He led the conquest of the land of Canaan
Jehu	His prayer led to the destruction of the Assyrian army
Elijah	He caused Israel’s Kingdom to be divided
Moses	This person rescued the spies in Jericho
Saul	She married a man named Boaz
Enoch	He was the second in command of all Egypt
Haggar	He was rescued from the mouth of lions
