BOOK STUDIES

None Like Him • Jen Wilkin • 10 weeks

God is self-existent, self-sufficient, eternal, immutable, omnipresent, omniscient, omnipotent, sovereign, infinite, and incomprehensible. We're not. And that's a good thing. Our limitations are by design. We were never meant to be God. But at the root of every sin is our rebellious desire to possess attributes that belong to God alone. Calling us to embrace our limits as a means of glorifying God's limitless power, Jen Wilkin invites us to celebrate the freedom that comes when we rest in letting God be God.

BIBLE STUDIES - OLD TESTAMENT

Judges • Lydia Brownback • 10 weeks

In the book of Judges, the people of God were mired in sin—from murder and violence to lust and adultery. The dramatic journey to the promised land may feel like a blockbuster movie, but it's a tragic story that illuminates the sinful nature of humanity. The Israelites' waywardness threatened to lead them away from their blessing, but despite their disobedience, God's undeserved grace endured. This study examines the biblical account of the twelve judges and helps women reflect on God's persistent grace as He carries the Israelites through Canaan and prepares them for his great purpose.

Jonah • Lydia Brownback • 10 weeks

The story of Jonah is about so much more than a great, man-eating fish. This short Old Testament book is actually a powerful drama about God's power, patience, and relentless grace—showing how God works out his purposes and how nothing can thwart his determination to save. Jonah's story is ultimately the story of Jesus and all believers as they learn to trust God and submit to his revealed word.

BIBLE STUDIES - NEW TESTAMENT

Saints and Scoundrels • Nancy Guthrie • 9 weeks

The story of Jesus in the Gospels features a diverse array of interesting characters, including some who claimed to be saints but proved to be scoundrels, as well as scoundrels who were transformed into saints. In *Saints and Scoundrels in the Story of Jesus*, Nancy Guthrie offers a fresh perspective on the individuals who shaped and motivated people such as John the Baptist, Peter, the Pharisees, Zacchaeus, Judas, Caiaphas, Barabbas, Stephen, and Paul. Join her as she reintroduces us to these biblical characters, helping us to see more clearly how they reveal the generous grace of Jesus toward sinners.

Through King Jesus, God reveals his righteousness, redeems his people from their sins, and unlocks the floodgates of his mercy. In this 10-week Bible study for women, Lydia Brownback examines Romans verse by verse to explore how God works through his Son and in the hearts of his people. Each lesson helps women understand

important doctrines of the faith, such as justification, propitiation, and redemption, on a practical and accessible level.
