Our shoeboxes are on their way to the child whom God has planned to receive it! It is wonderful to think that we can have a part in a child, who is thousands of miles away, hearing the Gospel. Just like the Bible speaks of the many parts of the Body having their role, so it is with OCC. We have packed and prayed and worked hard on our boxes. Now we release them to be sent to more than 100 countries where the children will hear the Good News at a Gospel outreach prior to receiving their box.

Long before the shoeboxes arrive in the various countries, there are volunteer National Leadership Teams that train pastors and community leaders who want to share the Gospel with the children. The leaders learn how to host a child-friendly outreach event and also how to teach the follow-up discipleship class, The Greatest Journey.

The Gospel is clearly presented and a Gospel booklet, The Greatest Gift is given to each child. For many children, not only is this the first time they have heard about Jesus, but this is the first book that belongs to them.

How truly amazing that we can be a part of this journey of a shoebox and a link in the chain for a child to become a child of God.

Please continue to pray for our gifts—pray that they will arrive safely to their intended child as they travel through customs and various terrains. Pray for the leaders in the different countries as they lead these outreaches. Pray for the children receiving the boxes that their hearts will be touched by God's Spirit.
