PENTECOST MAY 24TH, 10a

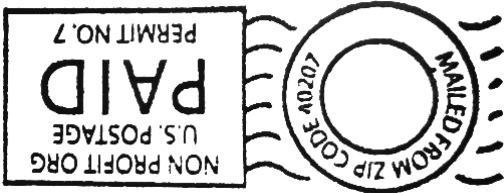

DIMENSIONS OF FAITH FEBRUARY 22ND, 6p

Join us for a lecture by photographers Bob Hower and Ted Wathen, Co-Directors of the Kentucky Documentary Photographic Project, which has been housed at St. Matthew's since 2017. They will discuss the Project's visual record of Kentucky from 1935 through 2055. This second iteration of the Project is the third time in a ninety-year period that photographers have roamed the state recording the landscape and how Kentuckians live, work and play. Their individual works are in the permanent collections of the Museum of Modern Art, the International Center of Photography, the Smithsonian American Art Museum, the KY Historical Society, the Boston Museum of Fine Arts, the National Archives, and the U.S. Dept. of State. In 2025, the Kentucky Documentary Photographic Project was given a major retrospective exhibition at the Frazier History Museum.
