### **Exodus Study #14**

**Exodus 14:1-31**

#### **1. Verses 1-9**

- a. Why did God lead Israel to camp in such a vulnerable place?
- b. What do these verses show about God's purposes in difficulty?
- c. How does Pharaoh's pursuit reveal the danger of pride?

#### **2. Verses 10-14**

- a. How did Israel respond when they saw Pharaoh coming?
- b. What does their fear reveal about our tendency to doubt God's faithfulness?
- c. What stands out about Moses' response in verses 13-14, and how can we apply it?

#### **3. Verses 15-25**

- a. Why did God tell them to move forward before the sea was parted?
- b. What does the pillar of cloud and fire teach about God's protection?
- c. How does this scene challenge us to step out in faith before we see the outcome?

#### **4. Verses 26-31**

- a. What does the defeat of Egypt reveal about God's power over evil?
- b. How does verse 31 show a moment of renewed faith and reverence in Israel's story, and how can remembering God's past deliverance strengthen our faith today?

## How to Study God’s Word Effectively:

Remember the simple yet powerful approach we’ve learned:

1. Soak in the Passage
  - Read the passage multiple times. Each time, pray and ask God to speak to you—inviting His Spirit to give you insight, clarity, and understanding.
2. Follow the O.I.A. Method:
  - **Observation** – Write down everything you notice in the text, even the simplest details. Don’t overlook the obvious—just note what you see.
  - **Interpretation** – What do those observations mean? Seek to understand the message and context of what you’ve written down.
  - **Application** – Based on what you’ve read and understood, how does this truth apply to your life? What is God calling you to believe, change, or do?
