Exodus Study #15

Exodus 15:1-27

1. Verses 1-5

- a. What event prompts Moses and Israel to sing?
- b. What key attributes of God are highlighted in the song's opening?
- c. How do these verses describe God's victory over Egypt?

2. Verses 6-12

- a. What do these verses reveal about God's strength?
- b. How is God's control over creation shown here, and how does God's power compare to human strength or the strength of Egypt?

3. Verses 13-21

- a. How does God lead and care for His people in verse 13?
- b. What future promise does God make for His people in verse 17?
- c. How does verse 18 summarize God's eternal reign?
- d. How do verses 19-21 show God's continued triumph, and what role do Miriam and the women play in celebrating Him?

4. Verses 22-27

- a. What is Israel's response to what they face at Marah?
- b. What solution does God provide through Moses?
- c. What command and promise does God give in verse 26?
- d. Where do the Israelites arrive, and why is this place significant?

How to Study God’s Word Effectively:

Remember the simple yet powerful approach we’ve learned:

1. Soak in the Passage
 - Read the passage multiple times. Each time, pray and ask God to speak to you—inviting His Spirit to give you insight, clarity, and understanding.
2. Follow the O.I.A. Method:
 - **Observation** – Write down everything you notice in the text, even the simplest details. Don’t overlook the obvious—just note what you see.
 - **Interpretation** – What do those observations mean? Seek to understand the message and context of what you’ve written down.
 - **Application** – Based on what you’ve read and understood, how does this truth apply to your life? What is God calling you to believe, change, or do?
