Exodus Study #8

Exodus 8:1-32

1. Verses 1-15

- a. How does Pharaoh's response before, during, and after the frogs reveal his true heart?
- b. Why do you think God allowed the magicians to imitate the miracle? What does this show about false power?
- c. Pharaoh breaks his promise once the frogs are gone. What does this teach us about repentance based only on circumstances?

2. Verses 16-19

- a. What's significant about this plague happening with no warning?
- b. The magicians admit, "This is the finger of God." Why doesn't Pharaoh listen, even after his own men admit God's power?
- c. How do people today ignore clear evidence of God's work?

3. Verses 20-32

- a. What is different about this plague compared to the others? Why is God's distinction between Israel and Egypt important?
- b. How does Pharaoh try to bargain with Moses, and what does this reveal about his heart?
- c. What are some modern examples of people trying to compromise instead of fully obeying God?

How to Study God’s Word Effectively:

Remember the simple yet powerful approach we’ve learned:

1. Soak in the Passage
 - Read the passage multiple times. Each time, pray and ask God to speak to you—inviting His Spirit to give you insight, clarity, and understanding.
2. Follow the O.I.A. Method:
 - **Observation** – Write down everything you notice in the text, even the simplest details. Don’t overlook the obvious—just note what you see.
 - **Interpretation** – What do those observations mean? Seek to understand the message and context of what you’ve written down.
 - **Application** – Based on what you’ve read and understood, how does this truth apply to your life? What is God calling you to believe, change, or do?
