THE HOLINESS

OF GOD

The concept of the holiness of God, in its essence, refers to the absolute purity, moral perfection, and separateness of God from all creation. It is a fundamental attribute that defines God's nature and character, setting God apart from everything else.

Holiness is derived from the Hebrew word "qadosh," which means "to be set apart" or "to be sacred." In the context of God, holiness signifies God's transcendence and otherness. God is not just another being within the universe but is wholly distinct and infinitely superior. This separateness is not just spatial but also moral and ethical. God's holiness implies that God is free from any form of sin, impurity, or imperfection.

In the Bible, God's holiness is a recurring theme. In the Old Testament, the prophet Isaiah had a vision of God seated on a throne, with seraphim calling out, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3). This threefold repetition of "holy" emphasizes the supreme and unparalleled holiness of God. Similarly, in the New Testament, the book of Revelation echoes this declaration, with heavenly beings proclaiming, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty" (Revelation 4:8).

God's holiness has profound implications for humanity. It reveals the standard of moral perfection that God requires from people. In Leviticus 19:2, God commands, "Be holy because I, the Lord your God, am holy." This call to holiness is a call to live a life that reflects God's character and moral purity. It is an invitation to be set apart from the world and to pursue righteousness and integrity.

This is today's thoughts. How do we live in such a way to reflect the Holiness of God and not a form of holiness that we have manufactured for ourselves.
