Sunday A.M. – August 10, 2025 Behold our God A Holy People Worshiping a Holy God

Worship is one way we respond to God. We express, among other things, thanksgiving to God with a sense of reverence and love. This is how we come to God every day, but there is also some input here as to how we approach God in our worship assemblies.

Jesus' interaction with the Samaritan woman at the well emphasizes that worship is not limited to a set time or place. Romans 12:1-2 tells us that offering our bodies as living sacrifices is our spiritual worship (service). That is a daily endeavor.

Worship, then, flows not only from temples and churches, but from the whole of creation—each sunrise, each act of kindness, each whispered prayer—an offering to the One who is, was, and will ever be.
