Main Idea: Don't Be Taken Captive by deceptive and enslaving false teaching.

Outline: Paul gives us two means to safeguard us from being taken captive:

- I. By Spotting Error (v. 8)
- II. By Knowing Truth (vv. 9–15)
 - A. Jesus is God in the Flesh (v. 9)
 - B. Jesus is the Sufficient Savior (v. 10a)
 - C. Jesus is Lord over All (v. 10b)
 - D. Jesus Effects a Spiritual Transformation (vv. 11–12)
 - E. Jesus Grants Spiritual Life (vv. 13-14)

9.	Why is forgiveness not a license to sin but a motivation to personal holiness? (Romans 6:1)
