WELCOME & CONNECT – ICE BREAKER

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell.

PRAISE & WORSHIP

Sing at least 1 dynamic praise song and 2 intimate worship songs. As leaders, we set the pace for Praise & Worship, led by example and with confidence!

ENGAGE – THE WORD

Ask the Members to:

- Highlight what stood out for them from the sermon.
- Share what they have changed since hearing the sermon on Sunday.

Tonight's Homecell is going to be an intentional open discussion, one that will get us thinking:

So, to start off tonight let us discuss the following questions:

- What does it mean to be a Christian in today's day and age?
- What does it mean when we say the Church has lost its love for the truth?
- What can we do to stand up for what we believe in, in our places of influence? School, work, campus etc.
- What does standing up for your faith look like even when there is opposition?

Read Jeremiah 10:12

Jeremiah 10:12 declares God created the earth with His power, founded the world with His wisdom, and stretched out the heavens with His understanding, contrasting His true power with powerless idols.

Let's discuss the following:

The God that we serve is a good God:

- **Creator and Eternal God:** Jeremiah 10:12 declares God created heaven and earth with His power, existing eternally before us as the true God, unlike powerless idols, deserving our worship.

- **Omnipotent, All-Wise, and Authoritative:** God's power, wisdom, and understanding in creating the world in Jer. 10 shows He is all-powerful and all-knowing, commanding us to listen and obey His voice.
- **Sovereign and Perfect:** As the Creator who reigns on the throne, God is holy, sinless, and without error, calling us to worship Him humbly from our place on the ground.
- **Loving and Unconditional:** God's act of creation reflects His pure, unconditional love, extended to us despite our unworthiness, flowing from His perfect nature.

Get two people to read: Isaiah 40:28 & Revelation 1:8

Isaiah 40:28 declares God as the eternal Creator who never tires and whose wisdom is unfathomable, affirming His limitless power and ability to sustain His people.

Revelation 1:8 declares God as the eternal Alpha and Omega, existing past, present, and future, the Almighty with supreme power over all.

Ask the members the following questions:

- How does prioritizing faith over thoughts and emotions affect your daily decisions and challenges?
- How does God's desire for a personal relationship through Jesus' sacrifice shape your view of grace and connection with Him?

Get a few people read John 3: 20, 2 Timothy 3:1-4, Amos 5:14-15, Romans 1:28-32 & Proverbs 29:27

Let us discuss what we just read:

- **Light and Transformation:** How does John 3:20's "light" reveal the need for change, and why do people resist it due to their "evil deeds"?
- **Self-Worship vs. God's Standards:** Using Romans 1:28-32 and 2 Timothy 3:1-4, how does prioritizing personal pleasure over God's truth reflects self-idolatry. How can we combat this in daily life?
- **Hating Evil, Loving Good:** Based on Amos 5:14-15 and Proverbs 29:27, what does it mean to "hate evil, love good" and "seek good not evil"?
- **Standing Boldly for Christ:** How can we preach Christ's love with conviction, and are we willing to face sacrifices or even die for our beliefs?
