ENGAGE - THE WORD

The scripture we focussed on this Sunday is 2 Kings 5:10-14 about Namaan, let us talk about what happened there.

Let the members who were at church, or that listened online share the following:

- What stood out for you from this sermon?
- What have you started implementing from what you learned on Sunday?



From what we just read and what the sermon was about why do you think some people are stuck in life even when they have a dream:

People are stuck because they are:

- Waiting on God.
- Waiting on people.
- Waiting for circumstances to change

Stop waiting:

- Action the instruction God has given you for your environment to change.
- God has already spoken, He's given direction, purpose, vision, and ability the next step is up to me.

Going back to verse 2 Kings 5 Elisha gave an instruction and Namaan obeyed, let us talk about this some more:

God gives the word but I must obey:

- Unexpected Messengers: God often uses overlooked or unlikely voices, to deliver life-changing messages. Don't dismiss a word because of its source.
- **Quiet Guidance:** God's voice sometimes comes in it's a still small voice. Be attentive to subtle instructions rather than expecting dramatic signs.
- **Obedience Over Expectation:** Naaman expected a grand miracle but found healing through simple obedience. God's instructions may not align with your imagination, but they lead to breakthroughs.
- **Beyond Pride and Intellect:** God's guidance often challenges human pride and logic, meeting needs in ways we don't anticipate.
- **Recognizing God's Voice:** When God speaks, you'll know it's Him. Satan doesn't plant divine connections or lead you to true healing and restoration.
- **Seize the Opportunity:** Heaven is waiting for you to respond to God's word, even if it comes unexpectedly.

Now that we know that let us think of the following questions:

- 1. What specific task has God instructed you to do?
- 2. Have you acted on God's instruction?

Because:

As we close let us discuss these points that sum the whole evening up:

- **Obedience is a Lifestyle, not a One-Time Act: True** obedience to God is not a single event but a daily commitment. It involves continually sowing seeds of faith, praying, attending church, forgiving others, speaking life, and making godly choices.
- **Don't Wait for Perfect Conditions:** Stop waiting for people, circumstances, or even God to align perfectly. When God speaks, act in faith immediately, trusting that He will fulfil His part.
- **The Miracle Lies in Obedience:** Like Naaman, your breakthrough isn't in external actions (e.g., the water) but in obeying God's voice. Faith and obedience unlock God's power and potential in your life.
- **Urgency and Faith Bring Longevity:** God is waiting for someone to respond to His call with urgency. Act on His word with faith, and your consistent obedience will lead to lasting impact and blessings.

WORKS & APPLICATION

Encourage members to share personal testimonies of times when God came through against all odds when the situation seemed hopeless, the diagnosis was grim, but God stepped in and turned everything around.
