- All of humanity is subject to unique temptations.
 - Jesus endured intense temptation and yet overcame (Hebrews 2:18).
 - He CAN sympathize with our temptations.
- The nature of the devil's attacks.
 - Ordained by God but not inflicted by God.
 - Jesus was loved by God and yet He was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tested.
 - You can expect the same!
 - Temptation came when Jesus was weak.
 - The devil found Jesus alone, hungry, and tired.
 - Jesus' temptation was unique and yet common to all men and women.
 - The ultimate temptation to glorify self over the will of the Father.
 - o God's Word was Jesus' defense!
 - Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. (John 17:17)
 - The devil's temptations were temporary.
 - Cling to the truth of God's Word... temptation will pass!

- 1 Corinthians 10:13:
 - o Temptation is common to all.
 - There is no temptation we can't resist (Hebrews 2:18).
 - There is no temptation God doesn't provide a way out of.
