

## PREGNANCY (

In February 2023, PRC made an exciting new addition to our Pregnancy and Parenting Education services. Since we were seeing a diminished interest in a weekly mom's group, in addition to women wanting their husbands or partners to attend, we decided to change things up. We launched a new monthly event, PRC's Pregnancy & Parenting Growth Nights. On the third Tuesday of each month, we invite men and women who are expecting or parenting a child aged two or under, to attend. This event is filled with great information from a guest speaker, sharing knowledge on a subject related to pregnancy and parenting. Speakers have educated moms and dads on a variety of subjects including car seat safety, breastfeeding, budgeting, nutrition, and infant and child development. Our guest speakers are professionals who graciously give of their time and impart their knowledge in their area of expertise. Domino's Pizza on North Atherton generously donates pizza each month, and meal volunteers provide veggies, fruit, and desserts. Our amazing team of Parent Advocates and Childcare volunteers help to make each evening a success, by interacting with the parents and allowing us to provide childcare.

Over the past year, 44 clients have attended Growth Nights! Also, donors and volunteers have participated and found the information to be both informative and encouraging. It has been valuable to offer something that includes both moms and dads to educate, encourage, and empower them on their journey as parents. 
