GODS PRESENCE AND POWER IN OUR LEADERS

I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. This is good and pleases God our Savior, who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.

1 Timothy 2:1-4

Key Ideas:

1. We have the power to affect the climate of our country and of our world
2. If you pray, it will affect whether your life is quiet and dignified

How do prayers affect leaders?

1. **Proverbs 21:1 - Canal** - *The heart of the king; God can dig so deep and change*
2. **Through Prayer** - *There's power. Cooperating with God to carve a channel of transformation*
3. **Daniel 2:21 / 2 Corinthians 1:11**
4. **Never underestimate what your prayer provides**

OUR CITIES

Upright citizens are good for a city and make it prosper, but the talk of the wicked tears it apart.

Proverbs 11:11

Key Ideas:

If we truly want God to heal our cities, we really have to pray.

1. **Bless - Berakah:** to bestow favor upon or speak well of something. We bless and speak well over our cities
2. **Esther 4 - God is calling us into action; pray for our cities**

Pray for:

1. **The Church's influence (Matthew 5:15)** - Salt and Light
2. **Peace over the city (Jeremiah 29:7)** - Pray against violence and unrest
3. **Protection from evil (Psalm 121:7-8)** - Keep us from danger
4. **Unity among people (Psalm 133:1, 3)** - As a church: unification, love, and respect so people can see a picture of Jesus
5. **Health and well-being (3 John 1:2)** - Healing from mental challenges, health care workers

If we want our cities to be impacted, pray!
When we pray, chains are broken, pain is healed.

NEXT GENERATION

For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.

Ephesians 2:10

Key Ideas:

They are the next generation of humanity, but they are the NOW generation of impact. Everyone's responsibility is to pray for the Next Gen.

1. We can't allow the enemy to carry the narrative of the next generation

Pray that they:

1. Understand their value (Romans 5:8) - *Something is only worth what someone is willing to pay for it*

2. Embrace identity (1 Peter 2:9)

3. We bind the enemy in Jesus' Name because we serve a God of Order, we serve a God of Clarity.

4. Fulfill their calling (2 Timothy 1:9) - *God has a call on your life*

Look at them as the NOW Generation of Leaders (1 Timothy 4:12)

God has strategically placed the next generation in a way that we can even let them be an example to us.

MISSION

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Acts 1:8

Key Ideas:

Our prayers don't just stay here; they can go global. Prayers travel very well.

Pray for:

1. The hearts (**Hebrews 4:7**) - *Open people's hearts, let them have a vision, let their hearts start asking questions, let them have a supernatural encounter*
2. The harvest/harvesters (**Luke 10:2**)
3. That hindrances be removed (**Hebrews 12:1**)

Call out for your city, county, state, country, world. That's how we touch heaven, heaven touches earth, lives are changed, and eternity is impacted.

VISION / DREAM TEAMS

The Lord gave me this message:

"I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations."

"O Sovereign Lord," I said, "I can't speak for you! I'm too young!" The Lord replied, "Don't say, 'I'm too young,' for you must go wherever I send you and say whatever I tell you. And don't be afraid of the people, for I will be with you and will protect you. I, the Lord, have spoken!"

Jeremiah 1:4-8

Key Ideas:

1. The call of God is not always an easy assignment
2. God has an assignment for everyone before being born
3. Make a Difference

You have a call of God in your life to make a difference and impact people's lives.

Luke 10:2 - There's plenty of opportunity, but not enough people to pull it off.

Pray for:

1. Workers
2. Raise up Christian leaders
3. Young people to answer the call to ministry
4. Our Dream Team Leaders
5. Our Finances
6. New Leaders in the Next Year
