Key Ideas:

- 1. Our faith is in His work**
- 2. Our faith is in His ways**
- 3. Our faith is in His word**

TRUTH FILLED

Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.

John 8:32

Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth

John 17:17

Key Ideas:

- 1. Identify the lies of the enemy: (John 8:44) -**
A lie believed as a truth will affect your life as if it were true. **(2 Corinthians 10:3-5)**
- 2. Declare the truth of God's word: (Isaiah 54:17, Ephesians 6:10-18)**

PEACE FILLED

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! ⁵Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. ⁶Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable if anything is excellent or praiseworthy think about such things. ⁹Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.

Philippians 4:4-9

Key Ideas:

- 1. Set the tone** - God is good, He is on our side, He is faithful, God will show up. It's a choice to set the tone
- 2. Peace that surpasses understanding**
- 3. See the lie (v.6)** - Ask God where our thoughts do not align with Him
- 4. Speak the truth**
- 5. Petition** - A formal request appealing to a higher authority with the anticipation of reversing something from a lower authority (2 Timothy 1:7). Petition out loud and with specificity
- 6. Seal the promise** - We do not retreat, we lean in. Choose the things of God and believe in them. When it's God, you will receive conviction not condemnation

JOY FILLED

The Lord has done it this very day let us rejoice today and be glad.

Psalm 118:24

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.

2 Corinthians 12:9

Nehemiah said, "Go and enjoy choice food and sweet drinks, and send some to those who have nothing prepared. This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the joy of the Lord is your strength."

Nehemiah 8:10

Key Ideas:

- 1. The joy of the Lord** - The unwearying gladness that comes from knowing and trusting God
- 2. Strength** - Place of safety and refuge or protection that comes from God's presence and power
- 3. Remember what Jesus did for us (Isaiah 61:10)** - There's value in remembering
- 4. Remember who we are in Christ (1 Peter 2:9)**
- 5. Remember to choose joy regardless of circumstances (Habakkuk 3:17-18)**
- 6. Remember to trust Him in everything (Romans 15:13)** - Trust positions us to be filled

SPirit FILLED

Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit

Ephesians 5:18

Key Ideas:

- 1. To be filled with the Spirit means I am emptied of myself (John 3:30)**
- 2. Holy Spirit transforms me (Galatians 5:22-23)**
- 3. Holy Spirit guides me (John 16:13)**
- 4. Holy Spirit empowers me (Acts 1:8)**

VISION FILLED

Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint; but blessed is the one who heeds wisdom's instruction.

Proverbs 29:18

Key Ideas:

1. When there's no vision, we drift
2. When we align ourselves to God's vision, we begin expressing the character of God in our lives
3. Romans 8:28-29 - Filled with the vision to be conformed into the image of the Son of God and to be connected with the body of Christ
