3 Radical Claims:

- 1. Jesus is the Messiah (v. 66-68)
- 2. Jesus is the Son of Man (v. 69)

"In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed."

- 3. Jesus Can Identify With The Canceled And Condemned


Learn from the Pharisees;
